Disaster Prevention (Drought)

Disaster Context

The northwestern region of Uzbekistan has been the scene of major drought during last three years. It is already under ecological stress due to the shrinkage of the Aral Sea and is facing water shortages.

UNDP accepted a request to provide assistance to government efforts to mobilize relief assistance. In recent months, UNDP's emergency focus has shifted towards providing assistance in formulating national and regional disaster prevention policies, as it is considered to be of highest importance in light of imminent water shortages in the region.

Programme Activities

- Assist the government in developing an immediate, medium-term and long-term drought recovery and mitigation framework, and provide practical advice to the central and regional authorities in planning and implementing the preventive measures
- Support the coordination functions of the government in the implementation of the drought relief activities
- Meet the urgent need for additional drinking water supply at the community level in the three most affected districts of Karakalpastan through installation of hand-operated water pumps
- Contingency planning workshop for Uzbekistan held in April 2003 in preparation for NATO exercise in Ferghana
