Election of the Bureau

Immediately following the opening of the session, the Executive Board will elect a Bureau consisting of a President and four Vice-Presidents with due account taken of the need to ensure equitable geographical representation. According to the established pattern of rotation of posts among the various regional groups, the President of the Executive Board for 1995 should be elected from among the Board members of the group of Eastern European States.
