I. INTRODUCTION

1. Regulation 5.1 of the Financial Regulations of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), which the Governing Council adopted by its decision 81/28 of 30 June 1981, gives the Administrator the authority to establish trust funds for specified purposes consistent with the policies, aims and activities of UNDP.

2. The present report covers all trust funds established by the Administrator during the calendar year 1993. A brief description of the activities of each trust fund is provided below and summary information of each trust fund is contained in the annex to the present document.

3. In accordance with Financial Regulation 5.1, the present report has been submitted to the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (ACABQ).

II. TRUST FUNDS ESTABLISHED ON BEHALF OF THE UNITED NATIONS  
DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

A. Trust Fund for UNDP History Project

4. This trust fund was established to prepare an informative, accurate and substantive history of UNDP, including its historical antecedents, its interrelationship with world events and an assessment of its record.

B. Trust Fund in Support of Peace-Building Activities in El Salvador

5. This trust fund was established to handle UNDP assistance required for the implementation of the peace-building activities in El Salvador and to play a crucial support role in the implementation of the peace accords.

C. Trust Fund for Democratization Support and the Electoral Process in Guinea-Bissau

6. This trust fund was established to receive and administer contributions for initial projects regarding preparation of the presidential and parliamentary elections in Guinea-Bissau.

D. UNDP/Denmark Trust Fund for Electoral Assistance Project in Burundi

7. This trust fund was established to accept funds from the Government of Denmark to provide technical cooperation and material assistance to Burundi for the purpose of undertaking free and fair elections.

E. UNDP Trust Fund for Human Resources Development in South Africa

8. This trust fund was established to provide assistance to South Africa for implementing the human resources development programme.

F. UNDP Trust Fund for Capacity-Building in De-mining Operations for Cambodia

9. This trust fund was established to provide assistance for the implementation of the de-mining programme of the Government of Cambodia, including the provision of the required technical cooperation for capacity-building that will enable the Cambodia Mine Action Centre to carry out the de-mining programme.

G. UNDP Trust Fund for Council on Health Research for Development (COHRED)

10. This trust fund was established to facilitate, promote and evaluate the Essential National Health Research Strategy (ENHR), whose goal is to ensure, for all people, health and quality of life on the basis of equity and social justice.

H. UNDP Trust Fund for the Reintegration of Demobilized Military Personnel in Mozambique

11. This trust fund was established to provide assistance to the Republic of Mozambique through the creation of a fund for the re-integration of demobilized military personnel.

I. UNDP/Norway Trust Fund for Assistance to the Electoral Process in Mozambique

12. This trust fund was established to support the preparation and organization of multi-party elections in Mozambique.

J. UNDP/Switzerland Trust Fund for Aid Management and Aid Coordination in Kyrgyzstan

13. This trust fund was established to finance the project Support to Aid Management and Coordination.

III. TRUST FUNDS ESTABLISHED ON BEHALF OF THE UNITED NATIONS CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUND

A. Environmental Management Guidelines

14. This trust fund was established to finance consultants hired to prepare guidelines to specify criteria and indicators for assessing environmental issues and impact of UNCDF project activities, to develop key issues essential for the improvement of environmental management and training to update staff on broader development policies issues relating to environmental management and to improve the approval and evaluation process of projects.

IV. TRUST FUNDS ESTABLISHED ON BEHALF OF THE UNITED NATIONS VOLUNTEERS PROGRAMME

A. Low-Income Urban-Community Participatory Primary Environmental Care

15. This trust fund was established for participatory socio-economic development and environmental management in low-income communities.

B. UNV Support to United Nations Inter-Agency Humanitarian Programme for Iraq

16. This trust fund was established to provide UNV services to assist in the implementation of the United Nations Inter-Agency Humanitarian Programme for Iraq in such fields as food aid monitoring and logistics.

C. Somalia Appeal

17. This trust fund was established to provide UNV support to the United Nations emergency relief and rehabilitation programme for Somalia.

D. Special Emergency Programme for the Horn of Africa (SEPHA) Appeal - 1993

18. This trust fund was established to provide services for SEPHA appeals for Ethiopia, Kenya, Eritrea and Sudan.

E. Development of Basic Education in the North-western Provinces (NWP) in Cambodia

19. This trust fund was established to strengthen temple learning centres in selected northern provinces of Cambodia.

F. UNV Specialists to Support UNHCR Humanitarian Assistance Activities

20. This trust fund was established to provide UNV services rapidly to UNHCR humanitarian assistance activities in the former Yugoslavia.

G. West-East-South Programme Support to the University of Eduardo Mondlane

21. This trust fund was established to finance lecturers at the Eduardo Mondlane University within the framework of the West East South Programme.

H. UNV Multisectoral Technical Support for Development and Humanitarian Assistance (Phase III)

22. This trust fund was established to provide technical expertise to selected developmental humanitarian assistance projects in Asia and Latin America.
