OPENING OF THE SESSION AND ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

Provisional agenda and organization of work of the  
Budgetary and Finance Committee

Note by the secretariat

1. In accordance with paragraph 4 (a) of Governing Council decision 81/37, the present document contains, in annexes I, II and III, respectively, the provisional agenda, the tentative schedule of work, and the list of documents for the Budgetary and Finance Committee for the fortieth session of the Governing Council. The session will begin at United Nations Headquarters on Monday, 1 June 1993.
2. The Governing Council approved the provisional agenda for its fortieth session (decision 93/1) at its organizational meeting in February 1993 and decided to allocate the following items to the Budgetary and Finance Committee:
  5. United Nations Population Fund: financial, budgetary and administrative matters;
  7. Other funds and programmes: financial and administrative questions;
  8. Financial, administrative and budgetary matters:
    - (a) Annual review of the financial situation, 1992 (including trust funds);
    - (b) Budget estimates for 1994-1995 and revised budget estimates for 1992-1993;
    - (c) Audit reports and other matters;

(d) Financial Regulations: Matters on which consensus has not yet been achieved;

(e) Procurement from developing countries.

3. In accordance with Governing Council decisions 86/53 and 93/1, the Budgetary and Finance Committee will also review the financial implications of draft decisions before the Council takes action thereon. Consequently, provision must be made for the Committee to review all documents having financial implications, including draft decisions formulated by the Drafting Group and the Standing Committee for Programme Matters, as well as other matters that the Council may wish to refer to under item 5 of the provisional agenda of the Budgetary and Finance Committee. For the present, it is assumed that the following items may be referred by the Council to the Budgetary and Finance Committee. Tentative provision has therefore been made for these items and that are included in annexes I, II and III:

- (i) Item 10 (c): Senior management structure;
- (ii) Item 4 (d): Matters relating to the programming cycles;
- (iii) Item 10 (e): Implications for UNDP, in particular for OPS, of recent decisions on administrative reform of the United Nations Secretariat.

4. In accordance with the request made by the Council in 1988, the attention of members is drawn to the following General Assembly documents which relate to the subject of audit reports (BFC agenda item 3 (c)), a limited quantity of which will be made available at the time of the fortieth session:

- (i) A/47/5/Add.1 UNDP financial report and audited financial statements for the biennium ended 31 December 1991 and report of the Board of Auditors;
- (ii) A/47/500 Report of the ACABQ on the financial reports and audited financial statements and reports of the Board of Auditors.

5. Annex II provides a tentative organization of work for the Budgetary and Finance Committee for the period 1 to 18 June 1993, divided up a week at a time. It should be considered indicative in nature so that the Committee may be in a position to take up items on a more flexible basis. In particular, should it complete consideration of an item before the date indicated, it would move immediately to the next item on its work schedule.

6. Annex III provides a list of all documentation that relate to the provisional agenda of the Budgetary and Finance Committee.
