RATIONALIZATION OF THE WORK OF THE GOVERNING COUNCIL

Note by the secretariat

1. At its organizational meeting for 1992, the Governing Council adopted decision 92/2 of 14 February 1992 on rationalization of the work of the Governing Council.
2. In paragraph 9 of decision 92/2, the Council requested the Administrator to provide for the organizational meetings and regular sessions of the Council a table indicating the subjects included in the agenda for the previous year, the present year and the two subsequent years. As requested, a table of subjects considered by the Council in 1992 and subjects scheduled to be considered in 1993 and the two subsequent years is annexed hereto.
3. In paragraph 11 of decision 92/2, the Council decided to review at its annual organizational meeting additional possibilities for the rationalization of its work, including a review of meeting and documentation requirements. Bearing in mind that the General Assembly is currently discussing restructuring and revitalization of the United Nations in the economic, social and related fields, no new major initiative to streamline the work of the Governing Council is being proposed before the conclusion of the on-going United Nations reform effort.
4. However, further progress is being made in implementing the previous decisions on rationalization and streamlining of the work of the Governing Council (81/37 of 27 June 1981, 87/1 of 17 February 1987, 87/50 of 19 June 1987, 90/23 of 23 June 1990, 91/51 of 25 June 1991 and, in particular, the comprehensive decision 92/2 of 14 February 1992). The overall number and volume of separate reports have been further reduced. The regular session of the Governing Council was shortened in 1992 and it is suggested that the fortieth session of the Governing Council (1993) be concluded in less than three weeks.
