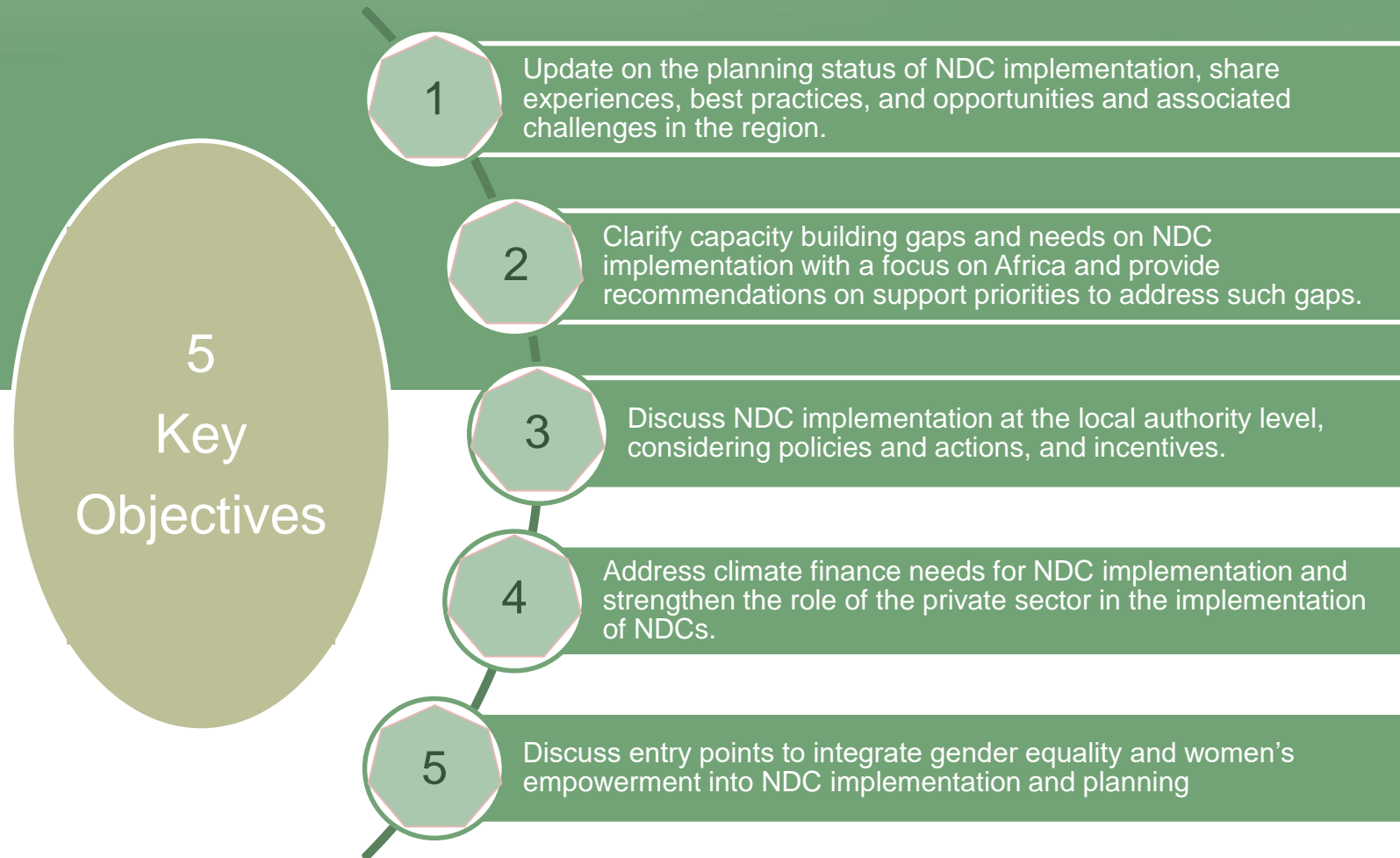

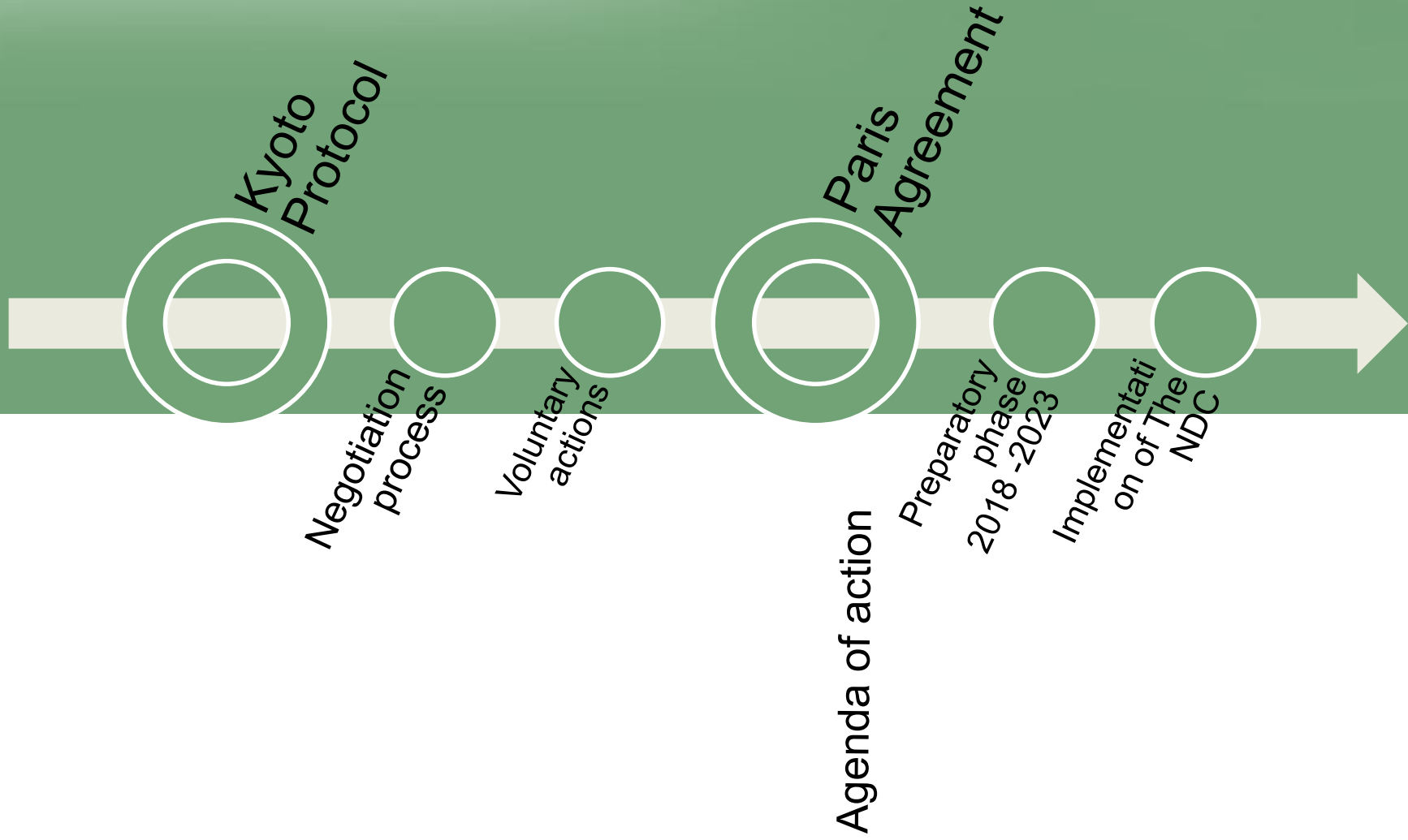

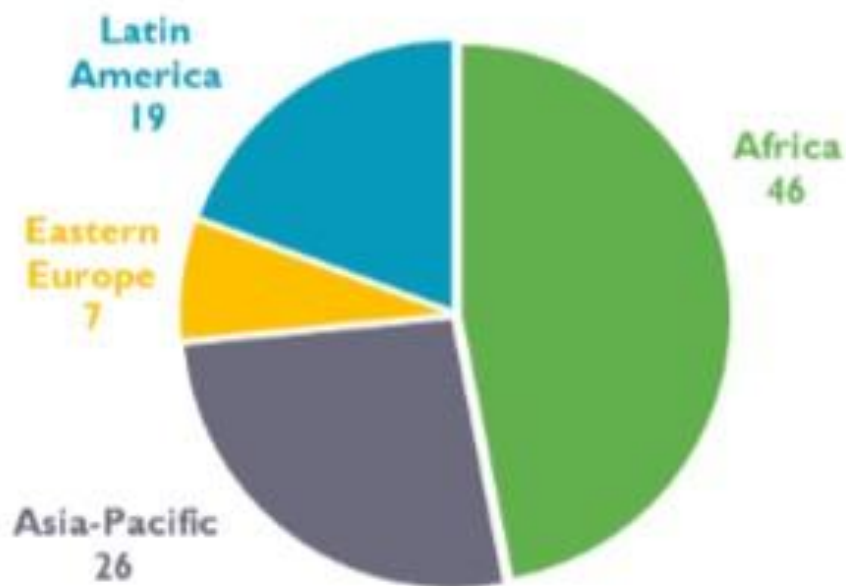


# IV- Adaptation drive the NDCs in Africa

Of the INDCs submitted and synthesized by the UNFCCC prior to October 1, 2015, 84% include adaptation components.

Figure 1 shows by region the number of INDCs that include adaptation. Among the countries RALI analyzed for this report, the same proportion (84%) included adaptation components, namely 31 out of 37 countries. Despite the optional nature of the INDC adaptation component, the UNFCCC concluded that adaptation is a priority for many Parties, and that adaptation is linked to a variety of national concerns including national development, security, and sustainability.<sup>28</sup>

Furthermore, the UNFCCC report notes that Parties identified synergies between adaptation and mitigation in creating climate-resilient development strategies.
