Call for Proposals

What is Youth Leadership Programme (YLP)?

The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) Arab States launched the Youth Leadership Programme in 2015. YLP's mission is to invest in young women and men across the region to unleash their potential to become social innovators, leaders and a powerful force for change in their communities, countries and the region at large. This goal has the potential of being achieved through supporting innovative approaches to sustainable development challenges, specifically focusing on gender equality and women's empowerment.

Youth participating in this programme receive ongoing support for their ideas, helping their communities throughout the year.

The main goal of the programme is:

- Help youth aged between 18 – 29 develop effective and sustainable solutions to address development challenges.
- Provide youth with ongoing technical support through a series of interactive hands-on learning workshops and targeted mentoring.

Since 2015, four YLP's regional events have been undertaken. This call for proposals is for the fifth phase of the programme.

YLP V:

For YLP V, a call for video proposals was issued by the United Nations Development Programme/Programme of Assistance to the Palestinian People (UNDP/PAPP) in cooperation with the Palestinian Ministry of Higher Education, a number of local Palestinian Youth Organizations, and Wattan Multi-Media Network.

Each video proposal submitted by the candidate must include the following elements:

1. The video proposal must not exceed 4 minutes from start to finish.
2. The video proposal can be in either English or Arabic.
3. The **first minute** of the video message must clearly reference the following information about the person submitting the proposal:
 - a. Name
 - b. Age
 - c. Place of Birth
 - d. Current Address
 - e. Whether you have a college degree
 - f. University/College/Vocational Training Centre attended
 - g. Affiliation with any youth organizations, and if yes, which organization.
 - h. Why is being a YLP participant important to you?
4. The proposal, which is **in total 3 minutes**, must clearly state the problem that will be addressed at the local, regional, or nationwide level.
5. Which of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) will you attempt to address?
6. What sustainable solution will you attempt to achieve?
7. How will it address gender inequalities?
8. What steps will you take to achieve the solution? What types of innovative tools or technology will you utilize? Who will be your partners, if any?
9. What budget amount is required to achieve such a solution?
10. If you already have a prototype of a solution, please inform at what stage of development are you and what is required for you to move it to the next stage of testing the solution.

Kindly send finalized video proposal to **Gov.papp@undp.org** under subject **YLP 5 Video by 25 September 2019**. All videos will be reviewed and scored by a group of peers focusing on the proposal's pitch, relevance of ideas/prototype to SDG development issues in the country, scalability, sustainability, gender equality, innovation, visualization, etc. Only short-listed candidates will be contacted.
