PROJECT INFORMATION

The *Aden Fishery Harbour Rehabilitation and Value Chain Development in Aden Project* is funded by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ), through the German Development Bank (KfW), and will rehabilitate the fish harbour at Hajif, to restore the minimum requirements for re-launching operations, productivity, and re-establishing effective management of the harbour.

The project will contribute to SDGs 5, 8 & 9 (Gender equality, Decent work and economic growth, & Industry, innovation and infrastructure) including employment creation, especially for youth and women, and mobilize the fishery value chain.

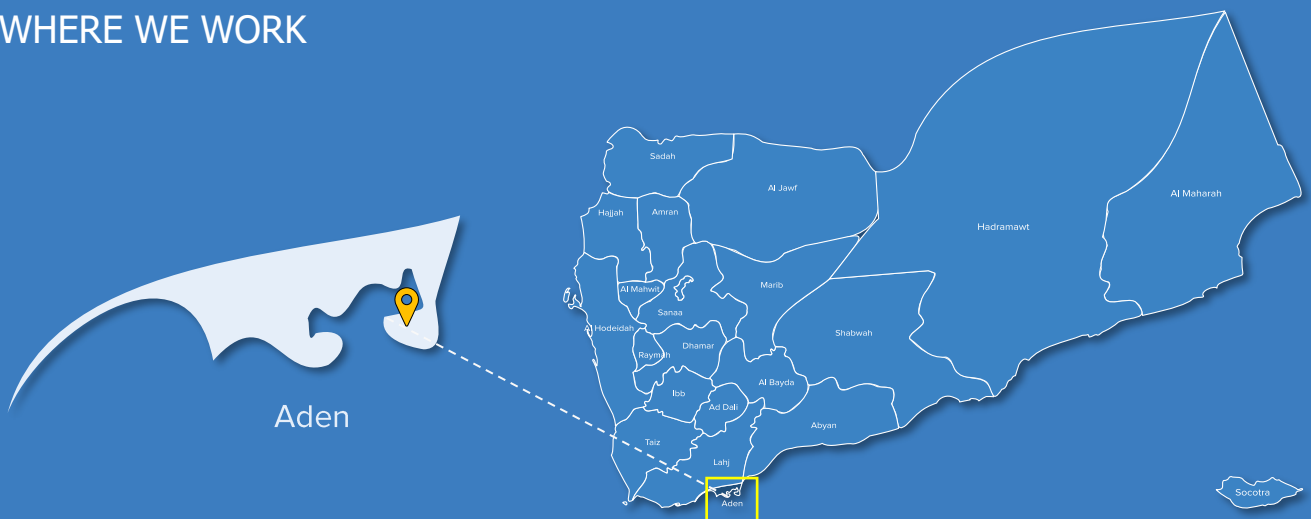
