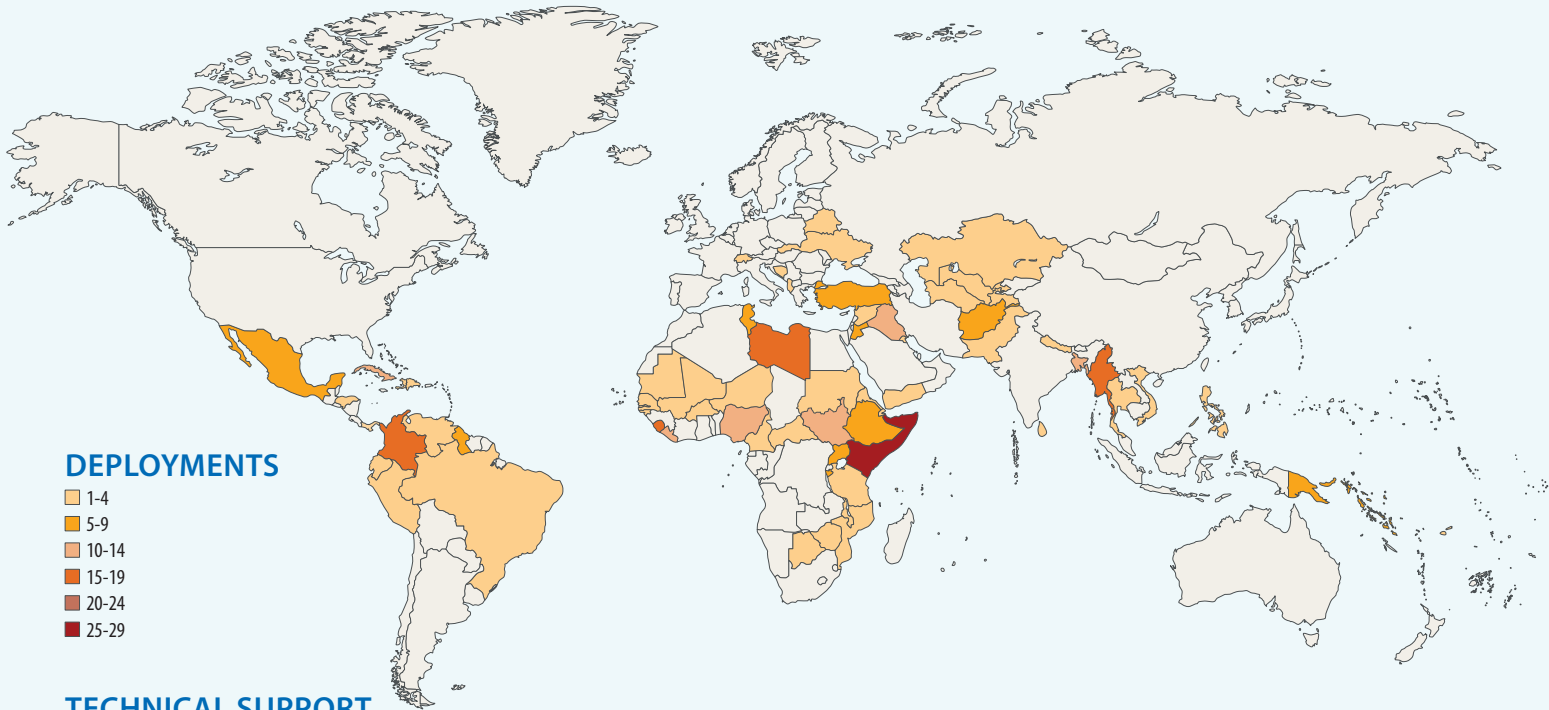

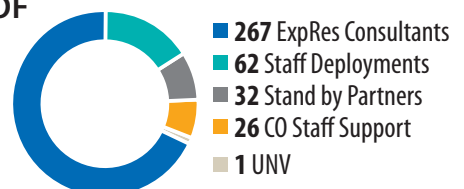
## 388 EXPERTS DEPLOYED TO 81 COUNTRIES WORLDWIDE IN 2017 TO SUPPORT CRISIS PREPAREDNESS, RESPONSE AND RECOVERY

- 124 deployments to 37 countries were funded by CRU (\$5,422,693)
- Average duration of each assignment: 3 months
- **Main thematic support:**
  - Disaster risk Reduction and recovery (14% of all deployments)
  - Governance (12%)
  - Operations and programme support (12%)
  - Rule of Law (11%)
  - Livelihoods and area based development (7%)
  - Early recovery coordination (6%)
  - Conflict prevention and peacebuilding (5%)

### DISTRIBUTION OF DEPLOYMENTS BY MODALITY

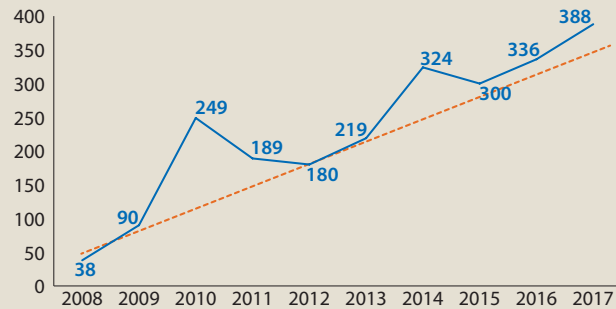


# UNDP'S ROSTERS FOR CRISIS RESPONSE

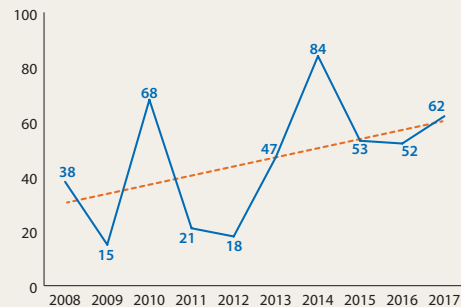
## TRENDS DEPLOYMENTS

### 193 SURGE Advisors

SURGE Advisors are UNDP staff with extensive technical and crisis experience with skills in immediate crisis response including technical/managerial, analytical and communications skills. Deployments are generally from one week to three months.

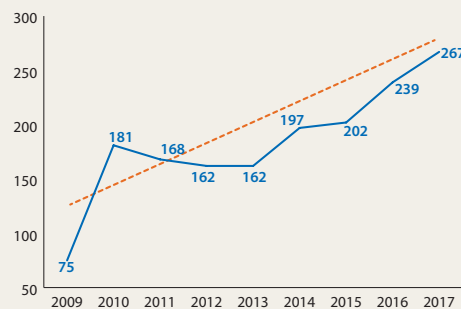
Over 20% increase of SURGE deployments in 2017 compared to 2016.

### 2,404 ExpRes roster capacity

The Experts Roster for Rapid Response (ExpRes) is a consultant deployment mechanism which maintains pre-vetted consultants for quick support to UNDP Country Offices. The primary purpose of this roster has been to deploy Crisis Prevention and Recovery (CPR) technical experts in the aftermath of a crisis, for recovery, prevention and for CPR Programming.

In 2017, a record of ExpRes deployments since the inception of the roster. Over 10% increase compared to 2016 and more than tripled since 2009.
