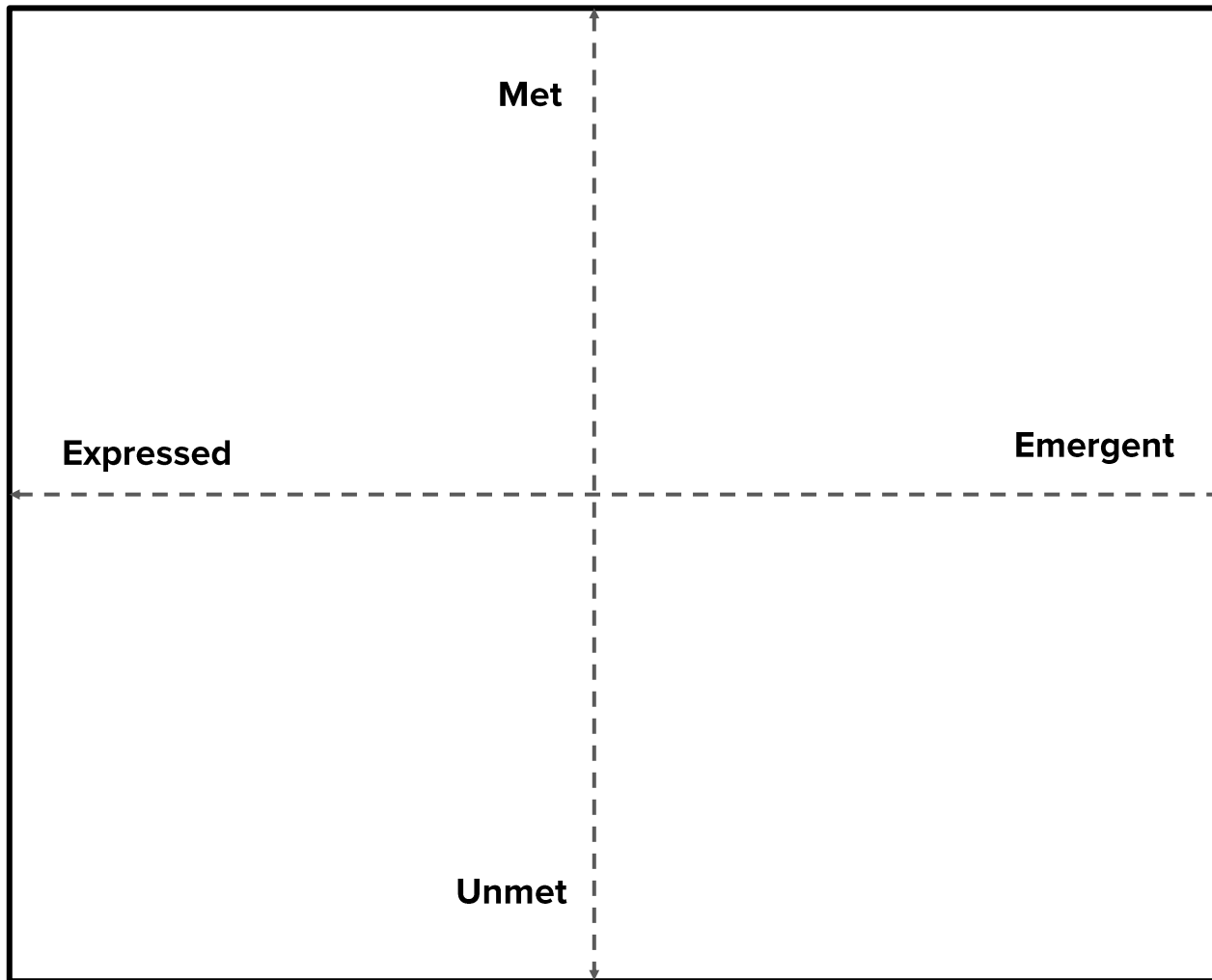


Please note these are just some examples to get your creativity flowing on how you may visually capture insights for your Windows/Strategic themes.

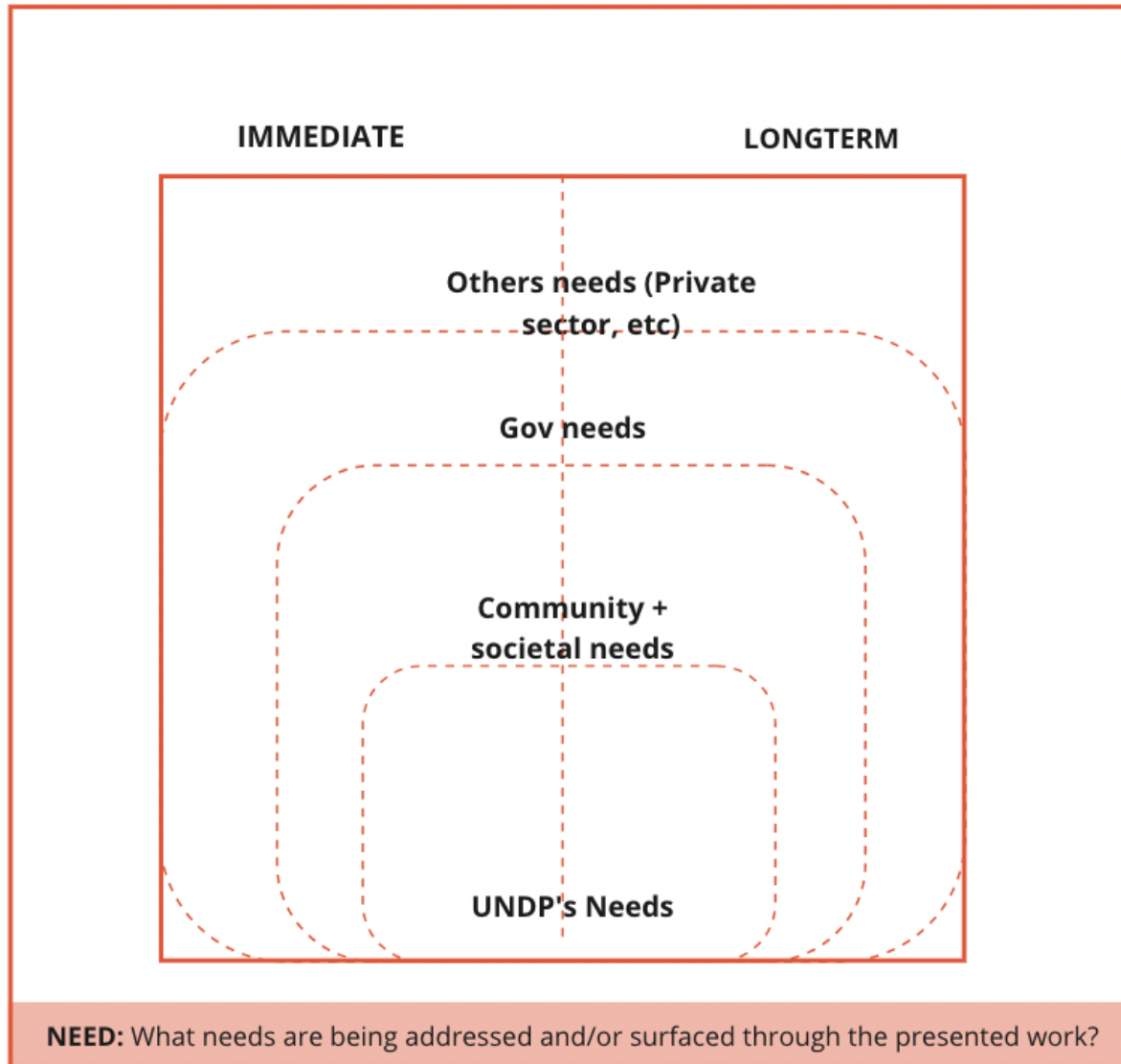
There is no right or wrong way- craft a visual frame that helps you capture what you most want to learn about as you listen to your office/team's work.
