

•Types of expenses and their amounts fully meet the needs of the project implementation.



Impacts on the environment

•Address particular environmental and climate challenges and clearly articulates the potential for impact.



Impact on the community

•Address relevant challenges and has a structured plan to create positive changes in the lives of communities.



Potential for gender equality

•Create the potential/likelihood to contribute to gender equality and gender mainstreaming.
