<b>Beneficiaries</b>	<p><b>Young people:</b> Between 18 and 29 years old at the time of the proposal submission.</p> <p><b>NGOs, CSOs, CBOs:</b> youth-led or empowering young people, the focal point should be aged 18-29</p> <p><b>Private sector:</b> start ups and companies led by a young person aged 18-29</p>
<b>Award</b>	<p><b>Financial:</b> Up to 20 000 USD/winner</p> <p><b>Non-Financial:</b> mentoring, training, knowledge sharing, communication</p>

## EVALUATION METHOD AND SELECTION CRITERIA



### Proposed Work Plan and approach

- Logical and structured scope of work with clearly defined, context specific and innovative deliverables and realistic timelines.



### Degree of Innovation

- Development of a completely new idea and/or is a new approach within the local context.



### Replicability and scalability

- Easily replicable or scalable



### Project cost feasibility

- Types of expenses and their amounts fully meet the needs of the project implementation.



### Impacts on the environment

- Address particular environmental and climate challenges and clearly articulates the potential for impact.



### Impact on the community

- Address relevant challenges and has a structured plan to create positive changes in the lives of communities.



### Potential for gender equality

- Create the potential/likelihood to contribute to gender equality and gender mainstreaming.
