Summary

The Summit on Sustainable Development was held in the framework of the 70th session of the UN General Assembly in September 2015. Following the Summit, the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development was adopted, which approved 17 Sustainable Development Goals (hereinafter the SDGs) and 169 tasks aimed to achieve them. Ukraine, as a permanent member of the UN, also joined the process of ensuring sustainable development and assumed the relevant commitments to achieve the 17 SDGs. An important component on this way is the issue of financing and strategic planning of implementation of the SDGs.

Ukraine made a clear commitment to include the 17 SDGs in its legislation on 30 September 2019, when the President of Ukraine signed the Decree “On the Sustainable Development Goals of Ukraine for the Period until 2030.” This document supported achievement of the global SDGs, taking into account specific features of Ukraine’s development. In order to carry out ongoing monitoring of the assumed commitments, on 21 August 2019, the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine approved Decree No. 686-p “Issues of collecting data for monitoring the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals,” which determined the principles of statistical monitoring of national and regional indicators of the SDGs.

The key stages of implementation and fulfilment of the SDGs in Ukraine¹:

Starting from February 2021, the United Nations Development Program (hereinafter the UNDP) in Ukraine, jointly with the World Health Organisation (WHO), the United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund (UNICEF) and the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) had been implementing a global Joint Programme "Promoting Strategic Planning and Financing for Sustainable Development on National and Regional Level in Ukraine". The initiative was created with the aim to optimize distribution of resources and coordinate the areas of their use with the long-term national development priorities and tasks for achieving the SDGs in Ukraine.

In order to strengthen the processes of strategic planning and budgeting of the SDGs at the national and regional level in Ukraine, an important task is to increase institutional capacity of the state authorities and local self-government bodies, in particular, awareness and competence of their representatives in these areas. Within the framework of implementation of the Joint Program and on the basis of the assumed commitments, Ernst & Young LLC (EY) in Ukraine conducted an analytical review of the available training courses and educational programs related to strategic planning and financing of the SDGs for civil servants, the public and business. The review covered the period of 2017–2021, and its main focus was on training programs for civil servants and representatives of local self-government bodies in Ukraine that are publicly available on a permanent and free basis.

Section 1 provides a list of training programs (courses/trainings/forums/webinars) held in Ukraine or available online in Ukrainian. All presented training programs are divided into those conducted on an ongoing basis and those conducted only once. Description of each program contains its form, providers (course organisers), target audience, public availability of materials, purpose and goal, as well as relevance to strategic planning and financing of the SDGs in Ukraine. **Appendix 1** provides a summary of background information on all Ukrainian educational programs described in Section 1 of this review.

This review is primarily focused on training programs specifically aimed at the Ukrainian-speaking audience, i.e. those that were organised or conducted in Ukraine and are available in the Ukrainian language. However, three English-language educational programs available to international audience were additionally reviewed in **Section 2** of this report. Such international programs are directly related to the topics of strategic planning and financing of the SDGs and can be useful for civil servants as self-study materials.

The following approaches were used to search for the existing training programs to be included in the analysis:

- The purpose of this review was to primarily cover training programs and resources for civil servants at all levels in Ukraine. For a more complete picture of the available educational opportunities, programs for business and general public were also analysed.
- The review was focused on educational programs available in the Ukrainian language on online platforms or offline educational events held in Ukraine for Ukrainian audience.
- The review was based on training programs and resources that may be available to all learners and information about which is available in the open sources.
- The sources of information about online programs included, first of all, relevant Ukrainian educational online platforms such as [Prometheus](#), [Educational Era](#), educational projects on [Diia.Business](#) portal and [Infobox Prozorro](#) information resource, [VUM online](#). The sources of information about one-time/offline training events included informational announcements about such events posted on the Internet resources of public and international organisations, regional administrations, state authorities, media, etc.



- This review was primarily focused on those training programs and resources that fully or partially covered such topics as strategic planning, financing, budgeting of all SDGs in general or individual SDGs. So, in addition to specific thematic programs, the analysis also included those educational programs that give the wide audience a general understanding of the topic of the Sustainable Development Goals and their implementation in the national context of Ukraine.

The analytical review showed that, in most cases, training programs available in Ukraine cover only general concepts of sustainable development and the SDGs, and only some programs partially cover issues of strategic planning and financing of individual SDGs. Currently, there are no developed educational materials and courses in the Ukrainian language in Ukraine that would fully cover this topic. A large number of useful materials and educational tools have already been developed by UNDP at the international level and are available in English, which limits the ability of civil servants to qualitatively understand and master information to some extent. Thus, the need to develop an integrated and comprehensive course for the Ukrainian audience on the topic of strategic planning and financing of the SDGs in Ukraine was identified.



Section 1.

Ukrainian training programs on topics related to the Sustainable Development Goals, strategic planning and financing for achieving them

Below is a list and a brief description of training programs, both offline and online, which were held once or are available on a permanent basis in the Ukrainian language. The reviewed training programs cover various aspects of sustainable development and the 17 Sustainable Development Goals, strategic planning and financing for achieving them in Ukraine, and are aimed at different target audiences: civil servants and local self-government officials, business representatives, and the public.

In addition, a brief conclusion was drawn on each of the reviewed training event regarding their relevance for the main topic of the Joint Program “Promoting Strategic Planning and Financing for Sustainable Development on National and Regional Level in Ukraine”; i.e. supporting training and improving competencies of civil servants and local self-government officials in the areas of strategic planning and financing of the SDGs.

Appendix 1 contains generalized information about all the reviewed training programs.

1.1. Courses available on a permanent basis

1. Course “What to Do Further: Explaining Sustainable Development to Civil Servants”

The course is a component of the general professional (certificate) training program for civil servants and local self-government officials accredited by the National Agency of Ukraine for Civil Service.</p> <p>Course results. In part, the course raises the issue of financing for the SDGs and discusses the theoretical part of the issue without practical mechanisms for introduction and implementation of the SDGs.</p>

2. Course “What to Do Further: Explaining Sustainable Development to Business”

3. Course “What to Do Further: Explaining Sustainable Development to Community”

Audience	The course is intended for representatives of public organisations and consolidated territorial communities, public leaders and activists who care about the economic, environmental and social issues of the country and the world, and who strive to be agents of change, play a transformational role and build functional partnerships with all stakeholders.
Availability of materials	Training materials of the course are available after registration on the website (directly during the course). The program with a description of the course structure is publicly available. The course is free of charge.
Description and purpose/goal of the course	Purpose and goal of the course: Help the public to understand the SDGs and how they affect their lives, as well as developing skills to engage stakeholders in dialogue to implement the SDGs. Course results. After completing the course, the participants will obtain: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • understanding of the purpose and goals of the SDGs; • ability to think in categories of sustainable development; • understanding of personal responsibility for one’s own influence on sustainable development; • understanding of causal relationships between economic, ecological and social components of public life; • understanding of the ways to define sustainable development goals and objectives for their community or public organisation, and to engage stakeholders in partnership.
Relevance for the program topic	The content of the course covers general knowledge and understanding of the SDGs and the role of the public in their implementation. The course is not directly related to the project topic, however, it can be useful as an additional self-study material for public servants and local self-government officials to acquire general knowledge about sustainable development and SDGs in terms of interaction with communities.

4. Course “Business: Sustainable Development”

Availability of materials	Training materials of the course are available after registration on the website (directly during the course). The program with a description of the course structure is not publicly available. The course is free of charge.
Description and purpose/goal of the course	Purpose and goal of the course: During short lessons of 7–15 minutes each, provide information on sustainable development, SDGs and benefits for business from implementation of the sustainable development elements in the company’s internal business processes. Course results. Following the course, the participants will learn: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • what the sustainable development is and where to start its implementation in the company; • how to choose specific sustainable development goals; • who should be the sustainable development leader in the company; • how to implement the ideas of sustainable development in all business processes of the company; • how these innovations can help businesses grow; • how to communicate and report on the company’s sustainable development.



Relevance for the program topic	The content of the course covers general knowledge and understanding of the SDGs and the role of business in their implementation. The course is not directly related to the project topic, however, it can be useful as an additional self-study material for public servants and local self-government officials to acquire general knowledge about sustainable development and SDGs in terms of interaction with business. In particular, they can make good use of the part of the course on implementation of sustainable development ideas in internal processes, including reporting on implementation of the SDGs at the business level.
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5. Course “Sustainable Development: New Philosophy of Thinking”

Year of creation	Available from 24 January 2019.
Provider	Platform: VUM online. The course was created by NGO “Open University of Maidan” and Klavdiia Shevliuk, the founder of Responsible Future.
Audience	There are no restrictions, anyone can attend the course.
Availability of materials	Training materials of the course are available after registration on the website (directly during the course). The program with a description of the course structure is not publicly available. The course is free of charge.
Description and purpose/goal of the course	Purpose and goal of the course: Provide knowledge and skills on sustainable development and SDGs to representatives of state authorities, the public and business who may be involved in the decision-making process in these areas. Course results. Following the course, the participants will learn about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sustainable development and its basic principles; • philosophies of sustainable thinking; • who is the driving force of sustainable development, what are their values and needs; • the UN 17 Global Sustainable Development Goals and the 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda, as well as the Ukrainian plan for achieving the goals; • application of knowledge about sustainable development and thinking in practice.
Relevance for the program topic	The content of the course covers general knowledge and understanding of the SDGs, covers the concept of sustainable development, as well as practical application of the SDGs in fulfilment of the commitments undertaken to achieve them. The course is not directly related to the project topic, however, it can be useful as an additional self-study material for public servants and local self-government officials to acquire general knowledge about sustainable development and SDGs.

6. Course “Green Public Procurement” (3 modules)

Provider	Platform: Prozorro. The training course was developed by Non-Governmental Organisation “GoLOCAL” and the training centre “Schools, Courses and Career Development” (SCCD) with the financial support of SlovakAid.
Audience	The course is intended for civil servants dealing with public procurement.
Availability of materials	Training materials of the course are available after registration on the website (directly during the course). The program with a description of the course structure is not publicly available, but the course page lists the topics covered in each of the modules. The course is free of charge.



Description and purpose/goal of the course	<p>Purpose and goal of the course: Raise awareness of employees engaged in the process of public procurement about the principle of “green procurement”.</p> <p>Course results: After completing all 3 modules of the course, the participant receives theoretical knowledge about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • green public procurement; • principle of estimating the purchase price using the life cycle assessment of a product, goods or service; • concept of responsible consumption as one of the SDGs; • advantages of green public procurement; • environmental labelling; • mechanism for determining green criteria and including them in the tender documentation.
Relevance for the program topic	<p>The course is aimed at providing theoretical knowledge regarding SDG No. 12 “Responsible consumption” in terms of green public procurement. This course covers highly specialized material that is currently the most comprehensive one in Ukraine on the topic of green procurement. Since green public procurement, which is a relevant part of sustainable public procurement, is one of the SDG financing mechanisms, the course can be useful for civil servants and local government officials engaged in procurement.</p>

7. Course “Gender-Responsive Budgeting for Community Development”

Year of creation	November 2018.
Provider	<p>Platform: Prometheus.</p> <p>Prepared by the US Agency for International Development (USAID) project “Policy for Ukraine Local Self-Governance” (PULSE), which is implemented by the Association of Ukrainian Cities, and the “Gender-Responsive Budgeting in Ukraine” (GRB) project financed by Sweden. The course is enriched with practical experience and materials from “UN Women” and the National Democratic Institute of International Relations (NDI) working under the USAID program “Decentralization Offering Better Results and Efficiency” (DOBRE). The course is taught by the team of NGO “Bureau of Gender Strategies and Budgeting”.</p>

Description and purpose/goal of the course	<p>Purpose and goal of the course: Teach civil servants to include the gender aspect in the planning and implementation of strategies, plans and budget programs of cities, villages and towns.</p> <p>The course provides answers to the following questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • how to take into account the needs of various groups of population in community budget planning; • why developed countries pay much attention to gender-responsive budgeting; • why it is important to implement this practice in Ukraine; • what results urban and rural communities got after starting to consider the needs of women and men in budget planning; • why it is beneficial for the community to have a gender-responsive budget; • why taking into account the needs of women and men, girls and boys contributes to the effective use of community funds. <p>Course results. Following the course, the participants will learn about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • approaches to implementation of gender-responsive budgeting at the state and local levels; • how to understand and include the gender aspect in the planning and implementation of strategies, plans and budget programs; • successful experience of communities that use gender-responsive budgeting in Ukraine.



Relevance for the program topic	The course is partially relevant to the SDG financing, as its content covers the issues of planning and financing the achievement of SDG No. 5 "Gender equality". The course is designed, among other things, for representatives of state authorities and local self-government bodies and explains the issues of budgetary financing and planning of gender-responsive programs.
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8. Course "Gender-Responsive Governance"

Year of creation	2021.
Provider	Platform: Educational Era. The course was developed with the support of the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and the British people through the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO). The content of the course was developed by the National Democratic Institute and Global Communities.
Audience	The course is intended for representatives of local self-government bodies, civil servants and anyone interested in the gender-responsive governance.
Availability of materials	Training materials of the course are available after registration on the website (directly during the course). The program with a description of the course structure is publicly available. The course is free of charge.
Description and purpose/goal of the course	Purpose and goal of the course: Provide information on how local communities can implement a gender-responsive approach in governance. Course results. Following the course, the participants will learn: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • why governance in the community should be gender responsive; • which legislative norms and successful practices should be taken into account; • what are the first steps the community should take on the way to implementing gender-responsive governance; • what tools to use to introduce gender-responsive governance in the community; • how to make services responsive to people's needs.
Relevance for the program topic	The course is partially relevant to the SDG financing, as its content covers the issues of planning and financing the achievement of SDG No. 5 "Gender equality". In general, the course is intended to teach gender-responsive governance to representatives of local self-government bodies and civil servants, but one of the course modules covers budgeting. Thus, the course covers both general issues related to gender equality, and issues of SDG No. 5 budgeting and implementation of gender equality principles in governance processes at the regional level.

9. Course "Gender-Responsive Governance"

Description and purpose/goal of the online course	<p>Purpose and goal of the online course: Increase the ability of public officials to analyse, form and implement public policies for the sustainable development of territories through development of effective multi-level governance in Ukraine based on partnership to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals.</p> <p>Online course results. Following the course, the participants will learn about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • regulatory framework, mechanisms and tools regarding the 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda; • global trends and best practices in the process of achieving the Sustainable Development Goals; • Sustainable Development Goals (tasks and indicators) adapted for Ukraine, specifics of institutional support for their achievement at different levels of public governance in Ukraine. <p>Participants will also acquire the necessary knowledge of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • how to choose modern tools for implementation of public policy for sustainable development of territories in the multi-level governance system; • how use innovative approaches to develop a strategy and specific sustainable development projects for the respective territory through the partnership of public authorities, business and the public; • how to determine areas, tasks and measures for establishing vertical and horizontal interaction in the process of solving specific issues for the sustainable development of territories; • how to assess and monitor the achievement of sustainable development goals at the state, regional and local levels. <p>Participants will acquire the skills of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • application of modern tools for implementation of the public policy for sustainable development.
Relevance for the program topic	<p>The course is partly relevant for strategic planning of achieving the SDGs. Its content covers the general issues of the role of public policy in implementation of the SDGs at different levels and integration of the SDGs in strategic planning.</p>

10. Online course “Application of the Theory of Change in Strategic Planning in Consolidated Territorial Communities”

Audience	The course is intended for representatives of state authorities and local self-government bodies, and anyone interested in strategic planning.

Description and purpose/goal of the online course	<p>Purpose and goal of the online course: Increase the institutional capacity of representatives of local authorities and civil society regarding the issues of strategic planning, monitoring and assessment of effectiveness of implementation of strategies, programs and projects for development of consolidated territorial communities.</p> <p>Online course results. During the course, the participants will be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • study the prerequisites for applying the theory of change in the practice of strategic planning of local development; • explore the strategy development process; • learn the basic concepts of monitoring and strategy implementation; • get acquainted with the gender approach, which is one of the main principles of strategic planning.
Relevance for the program topic	<p>The course is partially relevant for the SDG strategic planning, as its content covers certain aspects of strategic planning, however, does not link them to integration of the SDGs. In general, the online course is intended for introducing public servants to the process of strategy development, monitoring, strategy implementation, and gender approach in strategic planning.</p>

Section 2.

Foreign training courses on strategic planning and financing for achieving the SDGs

The issue of strategic planning and financing of the Sustainable Development Goals is one of the key priorities of Ukraine in the context of implementation of the 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda. In this regard, there is a need for systematic deepening the knowledge of representatives of the state authorities and local self-government bodies, both by using available educational materials in Ukraine and taking into account the best practices, experience and self-educational resources of foreign partners.

Despite the fact that this review was mainly focused on educational programs specifically for Ukrainian-speaking audience (which were organised or conducted in Ukraine and are available in the Ukrainian language), the table below additionally lists some foreign educational programs available for a wide international audience (in English). Materials of these programs were developed with participation of UN agencies and present the most up-to-date available information on strategic planning, financing and budgeting of the SDGs. These educational opportunities can be useful for representatives of the state authorities of Ukraine and local self-government bodies in Ukraine as self-study materials. They will help to better understand the issues of introducing the SDGs into the national planning system, taking into account the SDGs in the process of formation and implementation of budgets, and creation of national approaches to financing of the SDGs by all participants of the private sector, public sector and civil society. However, the materials of these programs are developed in English, which may limit the ability of the Ukrainian-speaking audience to effectively understand and master the information.

Conclusions and recommendations

Based on the analytical review of educational programs and other educational resources on strategic planning and financing of the Sustainable Development Goals, analysis of 32 educational courses, trainings or other types of educational events organised for the Ukrainian audience was carried out. In addition, the review included a brief overview of 3 foreign educational courses available in English. The analytical review included classification of educational programs by two main criteria, namely:

- conducting training programs on a systematic or one-time basis;
- Ukrainian (in Ukrainian for participants in Ukraine) or foreign training courses (in English for international audiences).


In addition, educational programs were assessed according to the following quality characteristics:

- SDG goals covered by the program;
- event format (online or offline);
- level of implementation (national or regional);
- providers and organisers of the educational event;
- target audience of the program;
- availability of materials;
- content, purpose and goals of the program;
- relevance of the program content to strategic planning and financing of SDGs.


Review results and identified gaps in capacity building activities

Among the 32 educational programs in Ukrainian, the majority (69%) were non-systematic, i.e. were conducted once. The rest (31%) of the programs are available for participation on a regular basis on various online platforms.

Number of programs by level of holding




Number of programs by regularity






More than half of the reviewed programs (69%) were available to the target audience at the national level. These are online courses and trainings available on a permanent basis, and some one-time online events. The rest of the educational events (31%) had local character and were intended for representatives of communities or local self-government bodies in certain regions of Ukraine.

Number of programs by year of creation or holding




All reviewed educational programs were created or conducted in 2017–2021. Over time, the number of educational events increased, and the range of their topics expanded. Among the 10 systematic online courses available to participants in self-study mode on a permanent basis, 2 were launched in 2018, 1 in 2019, and the most in 2020 — 5 courses, and in 2021 — 2 courses. Considering the fact that they were created recently, it can be assumed that all online courses are still relevant for participants.

Out of all 32 training programs, 11 (34%) were intended for public servants, 6 programs (19%) were intended for a wide range of representatives of the public. 8 programs were held jointly for civil servants and other categories of participants. There were 7 educational programs for representatives of business only.

Despite the great interest and importance of strategic planning and financing of the SDGs through national and regional budgets, there is a relatively small number of training courses directly related to these topics or their individual aspects that are publicly available on the Internet on a permanent basis. A number of conclusions can be drawn from the analysis:

- Most of educational resources do not comprehensively cover strategic planning and financing of the SDGs, and there are no programs that would reveal the specific subject matter aspects of these topics.



- The vast majority of existing educational programs focus on providing general knowledge of basic introductory topics such as the concept of sustainable development, the importance of achieving the SDGs, and introduction to the SDG targets and indicators.
- Only certain training programs focus on specific SDGs or aim to develop specific skills related to strategic planning, development of strategic documents or sustainable project financing processes.
- A series of online courses developed as part of implementation of the UNDP Ukraine project “Online Education for Sustainable Development” with the financial support of the German Government through Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH is the most thorough and available on a permanent basis for self-study by anyone. This series of courses includes three online courses: for civil servants, business and the public. They have structured programs and training materials containing useful practical examples of SDG implementation cases. However, these courses do not address specific subject matter issues of SDG financing that would be useful to civil servants in their work on establishing a systemic process for achieving the SDGs.

Conclusions and recommendations

Thus, in order to achieve the goals of strengthening the SDG budgeting processes in Ukraine, it is necessary to develop a larger number of specialised educational programs that would contribute to acquisition of subject matter knowledge and development of practical skills by representatives of the state authorities and local self-government bodies. In addition to highly specialized topics, such educational programs should comprehensively explain the relationship between global challenges of sustainable development and the systemic activities of governments and local authorities on integration of the SDGs into the processes of strategic planning of activities of the state bodies at all levels and into the budget process. It would be appropriate to introduce the courses that will be developed for civil servants in the future into mandatory advanced training programs for them.

When developing the courses, it is necessary to take into account the specific features of the topic and the target audience when choosing the format of their organisation and conduct. Thus, placing comprehensive thorough theoretical courses on online platforms with a permanent access for self-study is an effective solution from the point of view of attracting the largest possible audience of participants with minimum expenditure of time and resources for organisation of educational process. However, it is also expedient to hold practical field sessions in specific communities and in offline format, which will contribute to greater engagement in the learning process.

Development or organisation of educational activities with the aim of increasing capacity of civil servants to integrate the SDGs into the processes of strategic planning and budgeting should take into account the fact that these topics are complex and require knowledge and skills on a wide range of issues. Training of civil servants should be structured to cover both high-level general topics of sustainable development and specific subject matter professional topics; both theoretical knowledge based on the best international standards and practical skills to implement this knowledge in practice in the national context of Ukraine.

- 1. Sustainable development, importance and history of the issue.** At the beginning of the educational experience, it is advisable to get acquainted with the concept, the history of the issue, main events of the international discussion on various issues of sustainable development, global economic, social and environmental risks and opportunities, etc. It is important to highlight the significance of sustainable development and the relevance of the issue for representatives of the state authorities at all levels.
- 2. Theoretical knowledge on strategic planning, financing and budgeting of the SDGs.** The next step is to study the immediate topics related to development of the national SDGs, implementation of the SDGs into the national political system, development of aligned strategies taking into account the SDGs, integration of the SDGs into budgets, as well as monitoring the progress in achieving the SDGs.
- 3. Professional knowledge and skills for effective work of a civil servant.** It is advisable to build on the already existing knowledge and skills related to actual professional activity of civil servants. For example, such knowledge and skills can cover the topics of working with strategic documents, public procurement, budget development, planning and project management, etc.
- 4. Current state of issues of strategic planning and budgeting of the SDGs in the world and in the national context.** The practical block should play the key role in educational process and ensure that civil servants form the deepest possible understanding of the current situation regarding integration of the SDGs into strategic planning and budgeting both in the world and in a particular country. It is important to be introduced to international approaches and practices, and then learn to apply the acquired knowledge in the national context, taking into account specifics of the political system, public finance management system, etc. in a particular country.
- 5. Ways of integrating the SDGs into policies, strategies and the budget process in the national context.** Recommendations for integration of SDGs into policies, strategies and the budget process should also become an integral part of the learning experience, taking into account the diverse qualifications of participants and their role in the civil service hierarchy. The educational process should form an understanding of clear practical steps that can be implemented within the limits of an individual state authority and within the powers of civil servants. This creates an understanding among civil servants of their own role and importance of integrating the SDGs into their daily work.

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On the Joint Program “Promoting Strategic Planning and Financing for Sustainable Development on National and Regional Level in Ukraine”:

The programme implements comprehensive measures to support the Government of Ukraine in order to develop joint approaches to managing financial flows and the implementing the reforms related to financing of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. Due to cooperation at the national and subnational level, the Joint Programme aims to develop better methods of managing existing and potential financial flows, as well as coordinate the area of use of resources that can be attracted with long-term development priorities and achievement of the SDGs in Ukraine. Facilitating and supporting creation of the Integrated National Financing System Framework (INFF) of the Sustainable Development Goals is a key objective of the programme that will improve interrelation between the implementation of public policy and the ongoing decentralization reform.
