





PROGRAMMATIC APPROACH

- Strengthened the capacities of communities, 14 counties, and institutions for crisis preparedness, response, and recovery. As a result, 12 counties increased budget allocation for disaster management totalling KES 1,392,715,661 in the 2021/2022 financial year.
- Transferred skills and technology from Japan to youth, women, and refugees vulnerable to shocks from natural and manmade hazards. 1,322 youth and women benefitted and are utilizing the skills for entrepreneurship. This has increased household incomes and built their resilience to shocks.
- Enhanced stabilization and community-level adaptive capacity to build long-term resilience to shocks. In 2022,
 43,781 people (21,573 male; 22,915 female) with a further 242,207 benefiting indirectly. The increased income from the interventions has improved food security, health and education at the household level.
- Supported digitalization of Civil Registration Services (CRS) which has strengthened departmental coordination, and enhanced efficiency.
- Supporting the development and implementation of the National Action Plan on Business and Human Rights.
- Rehabilitating 300 hectares of degraded forest area in natural forests (250 hectares in Kaptagat and 50 hectares in Kakamega) and establishing tree nurseries in 20 learning institutions.
