Purpose: To increase the capacity of Ukrainian government institutions to address the consequences of war and to ensure continued delivery of services to the population; to strengthen governance at all levels, ensuring sustainability, efficiency, and transparency in responding to crisis and emergency situations; and to improve response planning between the central government, regions/districts, and other stakeholders (international community, civil society organizations, private sector) while increasing the resilience of host communities and internally displaced persons

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AREAS OF ACTIVITY

1 Strengthening the capacities at the national, regional and local levels of governmental institutions for more effective and adaptive crisis/emergency response and livelihoods creation

TASKS

- ▶ Embed Crisis Management and Early Recovery expertise within the governance structures at all levels of government and expand the technical capacities at both national and local levels to manage the response and ensure effective delivery of social services;
- ▶ Strengthen the capacities of governmental institutions to conduct sustainable recovery planning-implementation-monitoring activities at the national and local level to ensure accountability and transparency of the recovery process in Ukraine;
- ▶ Enhance the capacity of government institutions in strategic communications and countering disinformation to minimize the influences of fake news.

2 Strengthening crisis management structures with data/ information analysis systems enabling efficient response at all levels of the governmental institutions

TASKS

- ▶ Develop IT tools supporting the delivery of public services at all levels;
- ▶ Strengthen the capacities of line ministries on crisis coordination and communication through embedding new IT solutions;
- ▶ Support digitalization of the reconstruction, development, and monitoring process in regional development activities.

Expected outcome:

Governmental institutions at all levels more effectively lead crisis responses, sustain public service provision, and coordinate the delivery of assistance and recovery efforts guided by the principle of “no one is left behind.”
