Seven STAE Offices Renovated with Support from Japan and UNDP

December 1st @STAE Office, Dili

A hand-over ceremony of renovated STAE offices was held at the STAE headquarter office in Dili, participated by Minister of State Administration H.E. Miguel Pereira de Carvalho, Charge d’Affaires a.i. of Embassy of Japan, Ms.Kazumi Yamada, UNDP Resident Representative Ms. Munkhtuya Altangerel, President of CNE Mr. Jose Belo and Director General of STAE Mr. Acilino Manuel Branco. At the ceremony event, the UNDP CORE-TL project and Japan handed over seven renovated STAE offices to the Government of Timor-Leste.

With the financial support from the Government of Japan, UNDP CORE-TL project conducted renovation works of seven STAE offices located in Dili, Baucau, Ainaro, Aileu, Bobonaro, Liquica and Lautem. Each offices are designed to secure accessibility for people with disabilities and disaster risk reduction, equipped with access ramps for people with disabilities, accessible bathroom design, under-ground water tank pad, and rainwater harvesting compatible roof, as well as hand washing stations to prevent COVID-19.

The UNDP CORE-TL project will assist EMBs to build 6 new EMB offices; 3 buildings for the CNE in Covalima, Aileu, and Baucau municipalities, and 3 buildings for STAE in Covalima, Manatuto, and Viqueque municipalities. All the new buildings will be equipped with facilities accessible for people with disabilities, and disaster resistance including COVID-19 resilience.
