LOCAL GOVERNMENT INITIATIVE ON CLIMATE CHANGE (LoGIC) PROJECT

LoGIC is a multi-donor collaborative initiative of GoB, UNDP, UNCDF, EU and SIDA. It aims to enhance the capacity of vulnerable communities, Local Government Institutions (LGI) and civil society organisations (CSO) for planning and financing climate change adaptation solutions in selected climate vulnerable areas. The Local Government Division (LGD) is the implementing lead of the project in partnership with UNDP and UNCDF. Project priorities will be addressed through three sets of core actions: capacity building, providing access to climate change funds and policy advocacy. LoGIC is designed to support roughly 300,000 most vulnerable households in 72 unions in 7 districts of Bangladesh to fight climate change.

Established a climate financing mechanism for most vulnerable households and local government institutions.

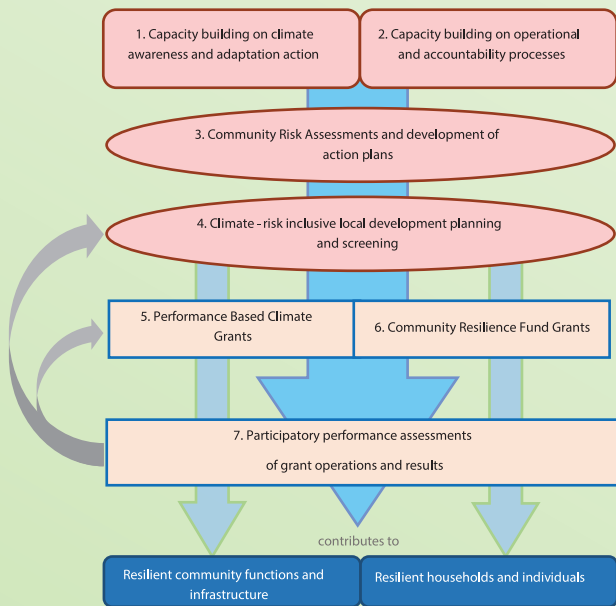

Enhanced financial inclusion through direct transfer of grants to the vulnerable institutions for implementing project actions

Economic and social empowerment by introducing most vulnerable women to formal banking systems for climate adaptive livelihood options through unified business plans to reduce investment risks

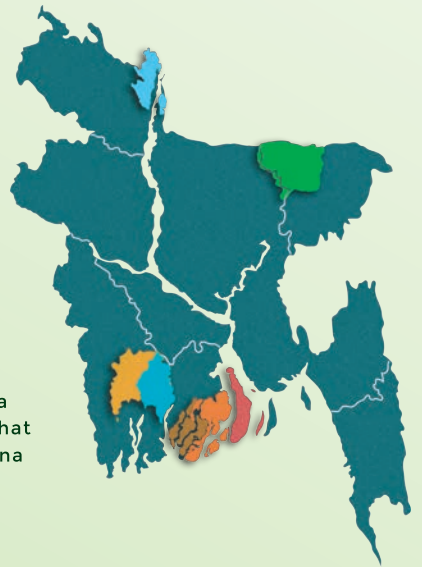
Mainstreaming adaptation at local level through climate risk assessment process and facilitating participatory representation of local government institutions and vulnerable communities
