Key achievements

- KP Prosecution Academy was constructed and handed over in 2022: the facility has the capacity to accommodate 350 trainees per year.
- In Balochistan, the Police Training College Quetta will accommodate 1000 additional trainees from its existing capacity for 700 trainees, upon the completion of the construction in 2023. UNDP's comprehensive support for provincial/regional RoL roadmaps included the establishment of delivery units to support
