EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

ata are crucial to human-centered policies and good governance. Digitalization has provided governments with considerable opportunities to improve public service efficiency and delivery while also increasing transparency and trustworthiness. The digitalization and digitizing of communication have enabled the publication of institutional public data through official institutional channels, improving transparency and accountability by making the data accessible to the public.

There is an expanding institutional agenda on data, in Kosovo¹. However, Kosovo is still facing substantial problems in the implementation of Open Data in the Western Balkans. Kosovo Central Institutions are finalizing its Digital Agenda Strategy, which will be implemented in 8 year period, and promoting access to Open Government Data (OGD) is placed at the core of its strategic objectives.² OGD emerges as a need to promote a data-driven culture in the public sector by developing frameworks that enable, guide and foster access to use and re-use the growing amount of data by increasing the openness and transparency and incentivize public engagement in policymaking and public value creation.

According to the findings of a study³ on real-time monitoring of the dataset quality of open data in the Western Balkans, availability of low-quality dataset formats appears to be the biggest concern impacting data reuse, resulting in an average 2.5/5 rating for data quality. In its roadmap for e-participation, open government, and open data in public administration⁴, Kosovo has been swiftly creating an overarching e-strategy and open government principles; nevertheless, implementation has been insufficient, and little progress has been made given that, so far, this has not been considered a key priority. Likewise, a study conducted on social media activity and presence, suggests that Kosovo is the least developed, compared to other five countries involved in e-government and open government.

This draws a map of the data produced within central public institutions in Kosovo by analyzing all the public documents that these institutions share online. By assessing how data is shared among public institutions and used in policy-making processes, the assessment provides a basis for recommendations for increased and effective use, collection, and management of data by institutions in the long term.

A total of 64 documents from Kosovo's institutions produced at least 261 records of Key Performance Indicators (KPI)⁵.

In addition, another 38 DOCUMENTS were examined from Albania, North Macedonia, and Montenegro, with a total number of 138 KPIs. All central public institutions were screened for strategic documents and data



availability and use. This allowed the collection of a significant amount of information which, together with qualitative data from interviews with primary stakeholders, created the basis for a comparison of the state of the art of data availability, transparency, and use within policy-making processes. While Kosovo shows a higher number of documents and KPIs collected for each of three line ministries compared to the other countries, it is noteworthy that Kosovo has a higher number of KPIs that are self-calculated rather than using different sources (such as Kosovo Agency of Statistics (KAS) or international options).

In addition to the desk research, a qualitative element involved 11 interviews to analyze the causes of scarce data use and data sharing systems, and to offer recommendations on methods to enhance data collection and use. The interviews allowed the identification of some of the main factors that inhibit the institutional ability to collect and exchange data. These include lack of resources (financial and human), lack of statistical offices (as organizational units), and lack of specific software for data collection. In addition, it was observed that some central institutions do not use KAS indicators, as they are not particular to their work.

Based on the analysis, this report makes several recommendations for potential systems or mechanisms to facilitate the sharing of data among central public institutions and KAS, and for approaches to enhance data collection, digitalization, sharing, and use for policy-making across Kosovo's institutions. The findings are in line with UNDP Digital Strategy⁶, suggesting four pillars of improvement:



The following recommendations have been drawn from this analysis:

Legal Framework

■ Improve the legal requirement for data exchange for some public institutions⁷, to push them to exchange data with KAS;

Monitoring

Create statistical units within line ministries;

Infrastructure

- Invest more in institutional software/databases for data collection;
- Improve public websites or create a centralized document management system for data publishing (as is the case in Montenegro);
- increase KAS working groups to coordinate work with public institutions; and

Improve Data Literacy

Provide more training on digital awareness.

OPEN GOVERNMENT DATA

pen Government Data (OGD) is a public administration process that encourages openness, accountability, and the dissemination of public government information to all citizens.⁸ Simply put, Open Government Data means that public government information can be reported, published on public channels, and accessed by anyone without any restriction. Massive amounts of data and information are produced and requested by state institutions. These institutions make themselves more open and answerable to citizens by making their datasets available. Governments can encourage the development of new businesses and cutting-edge, citizen-centric services by promoting the use, repurposing, and free sharing of datasets. Through the online dissemination of Open Data, several countries have started transparency initiatives for their governments and public institutions.

Government agencies usually manage open government portals, and in some cases, data is either not adequately supplied or selectively supplied. As a result, an international project known as the Open Government Partnership (OGP) initiative was established. OGP was to direct the Open Government Data process and secure specific commitments from governments to advance open government, empower citizens, combat corruption, and use new technologies to strengthen governance. Compared to EU members, Western Balkan countries and Kosovo launched the open data process later and are still working to improve the quality of the data provided. Even though Kosovo is not a member of OGP, Kosovo has vowed to respect the OGP's principles of open, accountable government data and has persevered in its attempts to enter the realm of digital governance.9 The Kosovo institutions has developed several initiatives under the "National Open Data Charter", including the E-Kosova portal, public consultation platforms, public service digitization, e-participation platforms and budget transparency tools. The release of data in Kosovo has increased during the past five years, primarily due to prompting from civil society. Open Data Kosovo (ODK), a non-governmental organization, worked with the Kosovo Ministry of Public Administration to create Kosovo's first open data website. 10 Open Data Kosovo developed a Regional Openness Index as part of the ACTION SEE project funded by the EU in partnership with the regional network of organizations with the same name.¹¹ The Regional Openness Index assesses the degree of institutional openness in the Western Balkans for people and society according to the following four guiding principles: (1) transparency, (2) accessibility, (3) integrity, and (4) awareness. According to the Regional Openness Index, measured over a period of four years, the Ministry of Local Government Administration received the best rating (81.24%) among the 46 institutions examined, while the Municipality of Leposavig/Leposavić had the lowest (0.00%); Kosovo's score for degree of data openness is 34.27%. According to this evaluation, Kosovo is behind Serbia and Montenegro, but ahead of North Macedonia, Albania and Bosnia and Herzegovina.

According to Open Data Kosovo, despite efforts to disclose all publicly available data in Kosovo this process is still in its early stages. They stated that "a stronger legal requirement will be vital to help positively boost the open data process and support the use of data for the public good. In particular, attention needs to be given to how compliance with data governance, open data, and data sharing rules will be ensured. Looking at data for the public good more widely, specific efforts should be made to raise awareness about the data produced in the private sector and the importance of using and opening it to both public and private sector stakeholders".

The Kosovo Digital Agenda Observatory¹³ identifies several issues to be addressed: among these, the strategic objectives of the Digital Agenda 2030 (not yet approved) should give great importance to e-governance, specifically the digitization of public services; and public officials' digital skills should be enhanced through new ICT training, in order to successfully implement the digitalization required by the strategy.




CHART 1. Regional Openness Index of Western Balkans MEMBERS.

The criteria for the use of open data in Kosovo are outlined in the law No. 06/L-081.¹⁴ As per the Law on Access to Public Documents, public institutions are required to actively publish every public document they generate, receive, keep, or control as soon as it is available for publishing but no later than fifteen days after becoming accessible. Article 2, however, states that public institutions are not required to produce, modify, or publish information summaries as doing so would require excessive effort beyond simple functioning. Because of this, public institutions cannot be forced to keep creating and storing a certain kind of public document for an external actor or another public institution for later use. The accessibility of all types of data is potentially affected by this act.

Producing specific data, such as statistics, briefings, or reports, can be difficult or time-consuming for them. Much information may be hidden if institutions feel that data is challenging to produce. As a result, the law may restrict the production of open data and hinder efforts to inform the public properly. The limited amount of information supplied by institutional entities may also result from this law, and to some extent the quality of the information may also be called into doubt. Therefore, further work is needed to change the law's original intent to ensure complete data accessibility and require institutional organizations to create public information actively, regardless of how challenging or time-consuming it may be.

MAPPING THE DATA PRODUCED IN CENTRAL PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS IN KOSOVO

To map out the data that are produced within central public institutions, Key Performance Indicators (KPI) were used. KPIs are used as a metric that better explain the use of data from Kosovo's central public institutions since the number of documents refers to the number of reports, strategic or other documents published by them. At the same time, KPIs show the actual data used within these documents.

The screening of the websites produced 64 Documents from Kosovo's central institutions. After analysis of these documents, 261 Records of KPIs were collected and categorized according to the publishing institution and the source (whether it was self-calculated, taken from KAS indicators, or other sources). The KPI was associated with the KAS categories if it was not taken from KAS. Another 38 Documents with a total number of 138 KPIs were examined from the other three countries, following the same approach as in Kosovo's (see Annex 1).

This number allowed a significant analysis of the quality of data produced by Kosovo's central public institutions and an assessment of their correlation with data produced by KAS. In addition, it identified data gaps and lack of data (e.g. in terms of indicators, data type, time coverage).

Chart 1 represents the documents and KPIs examined for each type of central institution in Kosovo. While the number of documents examined is the same for agencies and line ministries, the number of KPIs used in these documents are significantly higher in line ministries.




CHART 1. Number of documents and KPIs collected for each type of Kosovo public central institution

As Chart 2 below shows, almost half of the institutions have no documents published on their websites. There is also little documentation from the agencies or other public institutions: except the Ministry of Environment, Spatial Planning and Infrastructure, the Ministry of Industry, Entrepreneurship and Trade, and the Ministry of Local Government and Administration. Only 19 of 40 related institutions have at least one recent document in their websites, and only three have more than two documents published. (See Annex 1)

THUS, THE FIRST IMPORTANT FINDING IS THE LOW NUMBER OF DOCUMENTS (I.E. A SIGNIFICANT LACK OF OPEN DATA) PUBLISHED BY CENTRAL PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS.

The low number of documents collected indicates a lack of data shared from the central institutions; this was addressed during the interviews, highlighting several factors that influence this finding – please see the Findings and Recommendations section.

The Ministry of Internal Affairs published the most documents, with a higher number of KPIs. The Ministry of Finance, Labour and Transfers offers a low number of records on the website (4) but with a very high number and thus ratio of KPIs (50; see Table 1). The Ministry of Finance, Labour and Transfers and the Ministry for Regional Development show a significant number of documents shared (respectively 5 and 4) with quite a high number of KPIs (15 and 21).




CHART 2. Documents and KPIs for each of the line ministries and agencies

Table 2 presents the number of documents collected per type of Institution and type of document. The vast majority of documents are General, Annual and Strategic Reports (respectively 21, 9 and 22). Open data format was generally used for institutional budgets or other data purposes and, therefore, these were not used for this analysis.

IT IS NOTABLE THAT ONLY FOUR STATISTICAL REPORTS (PRESENTED BY THE KOSOVO JUDICIAL COUNCIL, MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND INNOVATION, AND THE KOSOVO ADVOCACY) WERE FOUND, AND DESPITE EXPECTATIONS A LOW NUMBER OF KPIS WERE PRESENTED.

While some KPIs date back to the period 1999-2014, most of them show recent data (mainly from the years 2020, 2021, and 2022) (see Table 3). This is due to the evaluator's practice of collecting only recent documents.

When looking at the Source of Data, it may be noted that the highest frequency is related to KPIs self-calculated by the competent institution (see Table 4).

166 CASES CAN BE DEEMED AS SELF-CALCULATED BY THE INSTITUTION, WHILE IN 44 INSTANCES KAS INDICATORS WERE USED.

This finding is significant when compared with other Western Balkan jurisdictions and in the context of the interviews (see below for the detailed analysis). It shows a lack of use of KAS information from central public institutions. Line ministries and agencies use KAS indicators in almost 17% of their KPIs. The other self-calculated KPIs derive from foreign institutions such as the World Bank, Eurostat, Transparency International, and the European Commission while some of them are from the Central Bank of Kosovo, the Central Election Commission, etc. The high number of self-calculated KPIs indicate the data-gathering potential that the institutions have and the low use of KAS data. The potential could be exploited by nurturing the collaboration between KAS and other central institutions to incorporate more indicators in their strategies, reports, or other documents.

THE HIGH NUMBER OF SELF-CALCULATED KPIS INDICATES A NEED AMONG CENTRAL PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS FOR MORE INFORMATION FROM KAS. ON THE OTHER HAND, INDICATORS FROM THESE INSTITUTIONS CAN BE INCLUDED WITHIN KAS DATA.

Indeed, many of the KPIs used by central institutions could be categorized according to KAS indicators and be used by KAS; alternatively, KAS data could have been used. Table 5 presents all the indicators divided by KAS categories (where applicable). The majority of KPIs are related to the population, justice, and education categories, linked to the main institutions from where the documents were collected. Comparing self-calculated KPIs with those coming from KAS KPIs (Table 6 and Table 5), it can be noted that there is a clear tendency to use more self-calculated KPIs for the same categories.

Table 7 shows the number of KPIs which could have been used from different KAS categories if addressed properly for each institution, or which could be integrated within KAS indicators.

Some of these indicators are very specific and might not be deemed important enough to be included in the KAS list of indicators. But as the qualitative analysis notes, among the reasons are the lack of legal obligation to communicate data to KAS and the lack of human resources and expertise to assure the quality of data.

FOR INSTANCE, THE KOSOVO JUDICIAL COUNCIL, TOGETHER WITH THE MINISTRY OF JUSTICE, MINISTRY OF REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND KOSOVO ADVOCACY HAVE A LOT OF INFORMATION ON COURTS, WHICH COULD FALL INTO THE JUSTICE CATEGORY. THESE DATA COULD BE COORDINATED WITH KAS TO ENRICH THE PRESENT INDICATORS.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS WITH THREE WESTERN BALKAN COUNTRIES

Albania, North Macedonia, and Montenegro were selected for comparison. Their data is included in Annex 2, Annex 4, and Annex 6. Three ministries were chosen, given the high number of documents and KPIs from the analysis of Kosovo's institutions: Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Justice, and Ministry of Health.

As a general note (see Table 8):

KOSOVO SHOWS A HIGHER NUMBER OF DOCUMENTS AND KPIS COLLECTED FOR THESE THREE LINE MINISTRIES.

ALBANIAN INSTITUTIONS SHOWED A HIGH NUMBER OF DOCUMENTS ONLINE, BUT ONLY A FEW INDICATORS WERE USED.

MONTENEGRO AND NORTH MACEDONIA HAVE A SIMILAR NUMBER OF DOCUMENTS AND KPIS.

Similarly to Kosovo, the other three countries have a higher number of documents that fall into the Report category (see Table 9). As an exception, North Macedonia has one open format document with 40 indicators, while Montenegro has a policy document with 23 KPIs.

Open data formats are absent or very rare in all countries and Kosovo. The lack of information that can be further analyzed by outsiders may be due to lack of public pressure for micro-data, or inability of public institutions to provide them, or unwillingness to disclose.

Table 10 represents the KPIs by institution and the source for each WB member. It is worth noting that the North Macedonian Ministry of Finance uses 40 KPIs from the National Statistical Office, while Albania only has 9 and Kosovo 4. Even the Ministry of Health in North Macedonia has a KPI from the Statistical Center, whereas other WB members list no more KPIs from their statistical centers.

This finding is interesting, given the high number of KPIs that Kosovo's institutions have used, compared to North Macedonia, which has fewer data but mainly draws on its National Statistics Agency.

IN ADDITION, IT MAY BE NOTED THAT KOSOVO HAS MORE SELF-CALCULATED INDICATORS THAN OTHER COUNTRIES, WHICH USUALLY HAVE WELL-DEFINED SOURCES FOR THEIR KPIS.

In conclusion, it may be noted that Kosovo demonstrates good use of KPIs in the screened documents.

ENHANCED INSTITUTIONAL CAPACITIES FOR DATA USE IN KOSOVO

Yet the use is limited to reports. In Montenegro, a policy document was found with 23 KPIs being used. This indicates a tendency to base public policy on data. While it cannot be generalized, it appears that Kosovo, like the other two Western Balkan Countries, shows a greater use of KPIs in reporting rather than supporting policy.

Open data was not used only in North Macedonia. The use and publication of open data from North Macedonia is related to the higher reliance on its National Statistics Office data, which assures the open format as well. This affirms the benefit of using KAS data, not only because of the reliability of data, but also the better format that it provides.

Another important finding relates to the source of KPIs used in the documents. Kosovo has 48 KPIs from self-calculated sources (accounting for almost 75% of total KPIs). Albania has 7 (some 30% of the total sources used), and Montenegro 11 (20% of total sources used). On the other hand, North Macedonia shows no use of self-calculated KPIs. The other interesting fact relates to the use of data from the statistical offices. North Macedonia has 41 KPIs from its national statistical office, accounting for almost 71% of its sources. Kosovo on the other hand, has only 5 KPIs (around 7% of the total KPIs), which confirms a rather low use of KAS data.

ANALYSIS OF SCARCE DATA USE CAUSES AND DATA SHARING SYSTEMS, AND RECOMMENDED APPROACHES TO ENHANCE DATA COLLECTION AND USE

This part of the analysis aims to:

- Assess the causes of the scarce use of data in policy-making;
- Analyze the existing data-sharing systems and provide recommendations on potential systems or mechanisms to facilitate the sharing of data among central public institutions and KAS, and;
- Make recommendations for approaches to enhance data collection, digitalization, sharing, and use for policy-making across Kosovo's central public institutions.

To address the above points, eleven interviews were conducted in July 2022, with general secretaries of line ministries, directors of public agencies, and personal contacts. Interviews provided in-depth analysis of the causes of the scarce data use in policy-making, an understanding of data-sharing processes, and how to improve data collection, digitalization and support to policy-making.

- 11 Interviews were done involving 17 people: face-to-face and 5 online
- there was also a face-to-face interview with the Head of KAS
- 2 other Interviews were canceled due to interviewee health issues
- Interviews ranged from 30 to 60 minutes

The interviews pointed out diverse issues regarding the use of data within the central public institutions of Kosovo. While specific topics can be noticed related to each institution's history, some common traits highlight the need for better use of digital data and collaboration with KAS.

The main findings are below. (See Table 12 for some key concerns from each interview.)

THEMATIC ANALYSIS AND FINDINGS

This section shows some of the main findings from the interviews. They point out several challenges that the public institutions face in coping with data collection, transformation, analysis, and publication (in aggregate or micro-open data format), which can be grouped into two main topics: (1) challenges with capacities and resources and (2) challenges with data integrity. The two are interrelated as the lack of human and other resources to deal with data collection, storage and analysis affects the integrity of data in all these steps – and as a result undermines data integrity.

1. Challenges with capacities and resources:

1.1. Awareness of the need for digitalization

The interviews show that all the actors are aware of the need for digitalization in their institutions. They recognize that digitalization would benefit them in better performing their duties. As one of the interviewees said: "We understand that in this century data should be online, and we are trying to cope with it." Nevertheless, there is limited awareness of the impact that digitalization in their institution would have on the public regarding access to data (possibly in open format) and transparency. This needs to be addressed through capacity building and awareness raising on the importance of digitalization within central public institutions.

1.2. Need for data for decision-making: lack of resources

Working with data is challenging due to lack of available human as much as financial resources:

- Almost none of the institutions interviewed had a statistics OFFICE. The exceptions were the Kosovo Probation Office, Prosecutorial Council, and Judicial Office. The interviews highlighted the risk to data integrity from lack of case management software and from human errors when inputting data.
- Institutions without a statistics office rely on Internal resources with NO qualifications in data management.

1.3. Collaboration with KAS is minimal in many cases

Despite the increasing need for data-based decision-making, the desk analysis of KPI sources showed that most institutions do not use KAS Data. Indeed, there were only 44 instances of KAS among the 261 KPIs mapped – 17% of the total. This was due to several factors:

- Interviewees observed that INDICATORS ARE PARTICULAR to their institutions' operations, therefore the institutions cannot use KAS data for their needs. This nevertheless creates an opportunity for central institutions to share their data with KAS. However, this is currently not the case.
- Limited staff with adequate training in data management results in a lack of access to, understanding of or exchange with KAS data online, and thus a lost opportunity to collect original institutional data and create a system for exchange with KAS. More training is needed to lower this barrier.

1.4. Lack of Software for Data Collection

A theme common to most interviews was that DATA MANAGEMENT IS HAMPERED BY THE LACK OF SOFTWARE TO RECORD, MANIPULATE AND CREATE AUTOMATIC REPORTING ON DATA. While some of the institutions mentioned different initiatives and funding from the Executive or other donors, currently all the offices were using Excel as the primary data management application. Representatives of justice institutions mentioned the SMIL (Synchronized Multimedia Integration Language) package, which is still being developed as a case management tool for all processes involving police, prosecutors, judges, probation services, etc. Other applications were not fully implemented due to lack of maintenance or because they were never fully developed (e.g. the predecessor of SMIL, a case management tool funded by the EU): This shows that:

- · Gathering data is labor intensive;
- Some statistics are not reliable due to the different methodologies used;
- Case management is complicated to handle with Excel.

Without a proper data management system, it is difficult to ask institutions to ensure the integrity of information. The lack of appropriate software and processes for data gathering, processing, and analysis hinders the ability of institutions to digitalize their work.

1.5. Lack of an institutional website

A common request supported for the development of a dynamic website where the institution in question could publish its data and increase engagement with the public. While the lack of a website is particularly apparent for agencies, line ministries noted repeated updates of the leading website with losses of published documents that could not be restored or easily retrieved. In Montenegro, by contrast, the *gov. me* portal offers a very flexible and easy way to find documents across different central institutions, while retaining the history of the documents.

1.6. Lack of obligation for data exchange with KAS or to publish information

Some interviewees noted that institutions would feel obligated to publish and share data with KAS and the general public if it was a legal requirement. Currently, the lack of legal obligation results in no real incentive to share the data.

1.7. Missing data storage infrastructure

Data are generally held on personal computers as there is a lack of servers and any kind of database infrastructure to safely store data. Datasets are elaborated individually, and in all cases, Excel is the primary application used to store data.

2. Challenges with Data Integrity

2.1. No methodology for data collection

While almost all institutions have created specific ways of collecting and analyzing data, concerns were raised about data integrity due to the general lack of Standard Operating Procedure on how data collection process works, how data integrity is assured, and who is responsible of the process. This was particularly highlighted in one interview, noting problems not only during the data gathering process but also during data analysis phase: "we have to worry not only about how we collect data from them [other institutions] but even about whether we come to different results since our methodologies differ and we publish the same results with different numbers."

2.2. Non-published data

Many interviewees pointed out that much of the data collected for internal use is not published on the respective website. This creates an excellent opportunity for improving data transparency with little effort since the data is already there.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Legal Framework

- Strengthen the legal requirement for data exchange is recommended. Besides the lack of resources (financial and human, resulting in a lack of statistical offices with specific qualifications in data management), lack of open data and data exchange among central institutions, that hinder the ability of Kosovo's public institutions to gather data, the lack of a comprehensive legal framework which pushes forward the open data process, creates a barrier to investing in or specializing human resources in data management. It is recommended that the law is revised, because it allows institutions to shelter from the production of data on specific topics on feeble or spurious grounds. The research conducted identified needs to boost open data and data exchange processes among institutions and with the public. Therefore, if the goal is to ensure complete transparency and help institutions to share and publish their data, and address individuals' demands who might demand that specific information, a change of this statute seems necessary. To guarantee the accuracy of the data presented, institutional entities should also be obliged to rely on it.
- Revise the law on access to public documents is recommended. Public institutions are by law¹⁵ exempt from producing, altering, or publishing information summaries when doing so would entail a great deal of work above what is necessary for essential operation. It is recommended to revise this law, because it allows institutions to shelter from the production of data on specific topics on feeble or spurious grounds. If the goal is to ensure complete transparency and help individuals who might demand that specific information, a change of this statute seems necessary. To guarantee the accuracy of the data presented, institutional entities should also be obliged to rely on it.

Infrastructure

- Improve institutional databases is recommended. No central data management software is used by the public institutions interviewed. This highlights the need to improve investments in such a direction as to enhance assets to facilitate data collection and exchange. It is recommended to invest more in specific software (such as SMIL in the judiciary) which collate data collected from different offices and institutions. This would foster data gathering, but also improve the quality of data and its reliability for public policy.
- Improve institutional websites is recommended. In some cases where data were explicitly collected from institutions, it was noted that some agencies lacked the resources to create an institutional website and publicly share their data. It is recommended to introduce Content Management Systems at the cross-institutional level that can be activated, used, and customized by the end users in each institution. This would be cost-effective in terms of hosting, set-up, and management of the website.
- Creation of a Centralized document management system is recommended. The interviews highlighted data integrity issues arising from the lack of case management software or human errors when inputting data. Different initiatives have been undertaken to address this, but never fully implemented.

ENHANCED INSTITUTIONAL CAPACITIES FOR DATA USE IN KOSOVO

Proper hardware (servers; backup systems) and software (specific data collection software; document management systems; public websites) are needed. While data sharing between KAS and other public institutions is a process that might require time and resources, some measures would nevertheless prompt and facilitate data publication. This process needs to be support strengthening of the legal requirement (first recommendation) as stated in the report.

The example of Montenegro shows that a centralized document management system enables institutions to publish their data in different formats (even open data) and even stores past documents (which have not been published because of website changes from previous administrations). Kosovo could therefore benefit from such as system.

Monitoring System

- Creation of central statistical units at line ministry level are recommended. Almost all of the institutions represented in interviews had no statistical office/unit or even staff with the appropriate background and experience, which consequently impacts data collection and processing. Most interviewees pointed out that, because of this, they have no data or if they do, they notice discrepancies with other institutions collecting the same data. This leads to misinterpretation of these data for public policy-making. A central statistical unit would have a powerful impact in creating sound methodologies for data gathering and improving data exchange with KAS. Dedicated resources would increase the effectiveness and reliability of data gathering and analysis and, therefore, the reliability of the information for public policy. The creation of central statistical units should be supported by a legal requirement as identified and expressed in the 1st recommendation.
- Increase of the ex-post impact assessment for public policy are recommended. Regulatory Impact Assessment is required for new regulations in Kosovo. If Increasing its use in ex-ante and ex-post assessment would create more demand for data and increase the pressure to adopt measures to enhance data collection and sharing.

People: digital literacy

- Increase of KAS working groups with other public institutions is recommended. As the KAS interview noted, there are precedents for KAS working groups with public institutions albeit principally with line ministries which actively contribute data management. It is also recommended to include more institutions in such working groups and to start more inclusive activities, such as:
 - classes/workshops on general training in data management;
 - inter-ministry groups to exchange ideas and identify data that can be shared.

This would have more impact on the general administration, and thus increase staff capacity for understanding KAS data and using it within processes. It would also prompt opportunities to build arrangements with KAS to gather specific data.

METHODOLOGY

Given the importance of open government data to openness and accountability, this report aims to understand the state of the art of digitalization in the central public institutions of Kosovo and to comprehend the primary factors and barriers that affect the ability of these institutions to disseminate general institutional information to all people.

The steps followed in conducting this research are as follows:

- **Step 1.** Desk research was conducted on data use by central public institutions of Kosovo;
- **Step 2.** Desk research was conducted to compare data use by central public institutions of Kosovo with that in Albania, Montenegro, and North Macedonia;
- **Step 3.** Interviews were conducted to deepen understanding of the use of data in the leading public institutions in Kosovo.

Below is a detailed list of steps to apply the research model.

STEP 1. Mapping the data produced within central public institutions in Kosovo:

A complete list of the central institutions was acquired from internal and external sources, including line ministries, agencies, and other public bodies (see Annex 1).

- This generated a selection of 53 institutions for Kosovo.
- Each institution was screened for strategic reports, action plans, documents, and other open data formats to search for KPIs.
- The documents collected were categorized by institution, location, type, and year of publication.
 - As a rule, only documents from 2019 up to 2022 were considered.
 - In some cases, where information was scarce, older documents were also considered.
- The KPIs found in the documents were categorized according to the type, institution, and location, as well as:
 - Source (whether it was a KAS indicator or other sources;
 - A classification based on the macro categories used by KAS and some additional categorization based on KAS to better interpret the nature of the data.

STEP 2. Comparative overview of data in three Western Balkan countries and identification of data gaps that exist in Kosovo:

Nine other institutions were selected from three Western Balkan countries: Albania, North Macedonia and Montenegro (see Annex 2).

For each of the three countries, the Ministry of Justice, Ministry of Finance, and Ministry of Health were selected as a base for comparison due to the high number of reports and KPIs found in the corresponding institutes in Kosovo.

- Each institution was screened for strategic reports, action plans, documents and other open data formats to search for KPIs.
- The documents collected were categorized by institution, location, type and year of publication.
 - As a rule, only documents from 2019 up to 2022 were considered.
 - In some cases, where information was scarce, older documents were considered as well.
- The KPIs found within the documents were categorized according to the document, institution and location as well as:
 - Source (whether it was a KAS indicator or other);
 - A classification based on the macro categories used by KAS and some additional categorization based on KAS, to better interpret the nature of the data.

STEP 3. Analysis of scarce data use causes and data sharing systems, and recommendation of approaches to enhance data collection and use

This final step builds on the above and deals with:

- the assessment of causes of the scarce use of data in policy making;
- analysis of existing data sharing systems, with recommendations on potential systems or mechanisms to facilitate the sharing of data among central public institutions and KAS;
- recommendation of approaches to enhance data collection, digitalization, sharing and use for policy making across Kosovo central public institutions.

In order to better understand the above points, a qualitative approach was followed by applying a set of interviews with key representatives from different public institutions in Kosovo. A list of contacts from all the institutions included in the study was collected. They included:

- General Secretaries of the line ministries:
- Directors of the Public Agencies;
- Personal contacts.
