Highlight of some key portfolio main achievements

Climate change adaptation and Disaster Risk Management

- Enhanced capacities of national and local institutions for management, conservation and sustainable use of diverse ecosystems;
- Enhanced mainstreaming of climate change consideration into national and sector development policies and plans, as well as in development planning at community level;
- Protection and conservation of 107,600 hectares of natural forest of the Green Belt Zone;
- Support of 4,500 drought-affected households totaling 21,600 people through the food-for-work programme;
- Support to 60 rural communities to develop and implement local disaster and climate risk informed inclusive community development plans;

Renewable Energy

40,000 individuals in the sub-towns of Areza and Maidima and 28 surrounding villages are benefiting from modern, affordable, and renewable clean energy

Food & Nutrition Security based on Sustainable land management and Climate

- Communities' support in the conservation and sustainable use of land resources;
- Enhanced flow of ecosystem services contributing to improved livelihoods and food security through improved crop, livestock productivity, and production
- Restoration and conservation of 834 hectares of fragile environmental and natural resources to support food security and drought-affected vulnerable people
- Date Palm Production and sustainable value chain development together with FAO and IFAD

Environment

Restoration and conservation of 45,000 hectares of landscape in the central and midland region through the protected area systems management and habitat restoration;

- Provision of training to 350 field experts and extension workers on GIS, ecosystem, and habitat management
- Strengthened environmental information and database for informed decision-making on environmental and economic policies;

Climate-smart Agriculture

 Support in the promotion and strengthening of improved and more productive cultivation of date palm;

Potable Water Supply

- 5,750 households have benefited from improved and safe access to drinking water services and practices;
- Technical capacity of local institutions and communities for effective and efficient management of water supply facilities enhanced through capacity-building activities;
- Improved quality of water contributed to improved livelihoods and fight against waterborne diseases;
