Summary

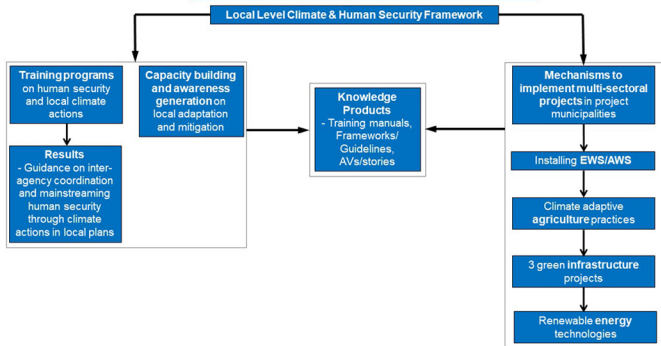
Nepal, despite having very low carbon footprint, is one of the most vulnerable countries to climate risks. Climatic extreme events, such as floods and landslides hit Nepal every year causing colossal damage to human lives, livelihoods and infrastructure. The country, therefore, has a strong vision of making Nepal a risk resilient society by 2050. 'Enhancing Human Security through Local Climate Actions Project' is geared to build resilience.

It aims to build a comprehensive approach on climate change adaptation and resilience through local actions focusing on human security. The project components include adaptive agriculture, energy, early warning system, community infrastructure and capacity building. This one-year project will focus on Nalgad Municipality and Barekot Rural Municipality of Jajarkot District in Karnali Province. It is financially supported by the Government of Japan/Japan Supplementary Budget and implemented by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP).
