Entrepreneurship Training responds to the needs of diversifying Timor Leste's economy, especially by fostering entrepreneurship among youth. This Entrepreneurship Program is designed by UNDP Timor-Leste and implemented in collaboration with Instituto de Apoio ao Desenvolvimento Empresarial (IADE) and the Bridge International in Korea with a joint fund from Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA) and the Government of Timor-Leste through Ministry Tourism Commerce and Industry (MTCI).

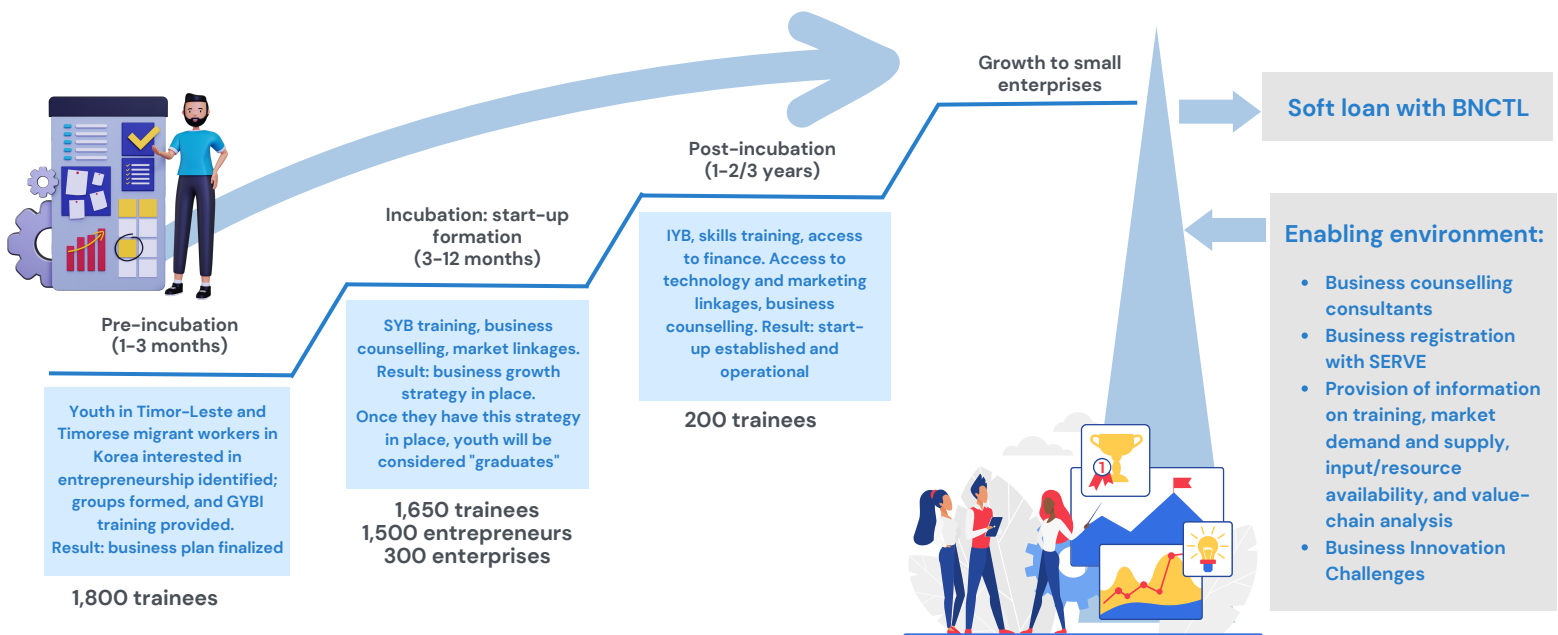
The entrepreneurship training is composed on three phases into pre-incubation training, incubation training, and post-incubation training to nurture Timorese youth to be capable of developing business plans and open their competitive businesses.

PRE-INCUBATION SESSION WITH IADE IN TIMOR-LESTE

The UNDP is operating a pre-incubation training with IADE, composed of several sessions to support Timorese youth to develop their business ideas and plans as follows:

- Understanding the definition of entrepreneur and how to become an entrepreneur
- Tailoring and shaping the business ideas
- Developing a business plan
- Choosing the market-oriented business idea and opening the business

PRE-INCUBATION TRAINING WITH THE BRIDGE INTERNATIONAL

By using the enterprise pools of the Bridge International, migrant workers with no concrete business ideas can select an item that they can commercialize in their home country and connect with the enterprise, the activities plans are as follows:

- Program curriculum planning and development
- Recruitment of participants
- Basic capacity building program
- Pre-incubation program
- 1:1 mentoring/customized consulting
- Post management
