### COVID-19 Resilience Plan/Manual/Training

EMBS ARE EQUIPPED WITH A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN & MANUAL, STAFF ARE TRAINED



- Issued 2 manuals and 5 supplementary notes to assure COVID-safe elections.
- 34,710 EMB and polling staff attended a cascade training on COVID-19 safety and first aid.
- Procured 9 items, including 825,800 face masks, 12,120 bottles of sanitizer disinfectant, 1,320 sets of PPE.

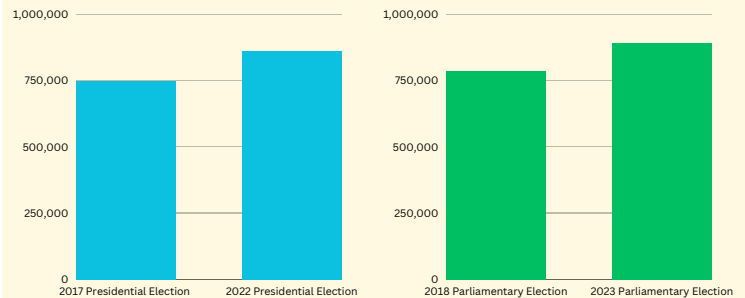

## Informed Citizen & Election

EFFECTIVE AND INNOVATIVE COMMUNICATION, A PARTICIPATORY AND INTERACTIVE DIGITAL INFORMATION PLATFORM

- Produced a new **journalism guidelines** for elections coverage and **233 EMB staff and journalists (40.5% Women)** attended the training session.
- Provided **12 Media Bus** to the national journalists to facilitate their election coverage during the Presidential Elections 2022.
- 97,222 people** visited **CNE digital information platform** for COVID and electoral information.

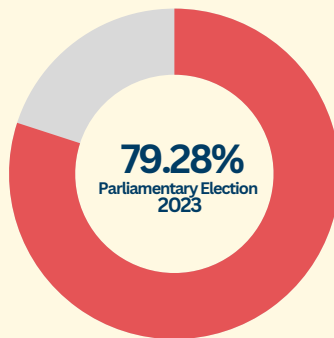
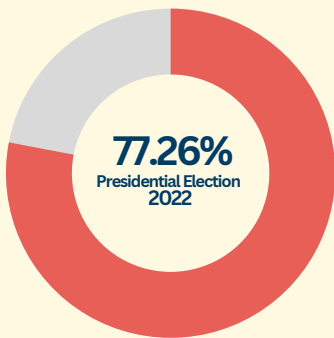


- Produced **58 ICE materials** to disseminate information on **voter registration, election procedures and COVID safety protocol.**

## Inclusive Political Participation

YOUTH, WOMEN AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES ENHANCE CAPACITIES IN POLITICAL PARTICIPATION AND REPRESENTATION



### Voter turnout 2022/ 2023

- Voter turnout Increased** : In comparison to the 2017 presidential election, 6.1 % increased in the 2022 Presidential Election and 8.12 % increased in the 2023 Parliamentary Election.

- 12,089 people** increased their knowledge on political participation and representation through the training co-organized with UN Women and CSOs.
- 5,418 youth, 5,748 women, and 6,598 people with disabilities** developed their capacity to participate in the elections.
- 152 people with visual impairments** attended braille training to gain electoral information.
- Conducted **Disability Inclusion Survey** with 9,601 PwDs from 252 villages in all 14 municipalities.
- Prof. Yamada Mitsuru (WASEDA University of Japan)** presented lecture and interactive discussion about youth's political participation with 237 university students (UNTL&UNDIL)
