				<i>Tara (Pljevlja, Kolašin, Mojkovac)</i>
Polja Residents Association	<b><i>Walking Adventure</i></b>	10	13,150	Apart from promoting hiking and horseback riding paths, the project will mark 40 km of hiking trails. It will also help improve existing mountain trails by upgrading their infrastructure. To further contribute to availability of tourist amenities, village households that provide accommodation services in this cluster will get the opportunity to receive high-quality training in content presentation and communication with guests.
Viva Vita	<b><i>Magical plants in our Town Park</i></b>	7	14,563	This initiative aims to improve the knowledge and skills of children and educators about medicinal herbs, increase the number of plant species within the territory of Pljevlja Municipality by setting up a botanical garden, and designate the Town Park as a monument of nature.
Lastavica (Swallow)	<b><i>ArtAction</i></b>	5	4,974	Since young artists are underrepresented in the policy-making process, this project aims to make them more visible, improve their economic status and actively include them in the cultural scene of Pljevlja, especially in promoting local values. "Art Action" implies the organisation of concerts, performances and exhibitions that will attract a wider audience and increase the recognition of the local artists' work.

Legalis	<b><i>Entrepreneurship School "Empower the Young"</i></b>	8	12,745	One way to alleviate the problem of unemployment is through activities like informal youth education in business and digital marketing, which help empower young people to launch their business, which is the key part of the project.
Association for Creative Youth Action Vesna	<b><i>Conservation of old craft in Mojkovac</i></b>	8	14,078	The memory of old crafts is gradually disappearing; moreover, Mojkovac lacks even an exhibition of traditional products such as costumes, bedspreads, rugs... Hence, the project aims to increase the knowledge of young people about rare and valuable crafts, while at the same time improving the cultural offer of the town.
Magical fingers	<b><i>Small deeds - large impact</i></b>	7	4,990	The project focuses on collecting recyclables to be used for educational games, to be followed by trainings for teachers and parents on how to create educational and social games tailored to the child's needs.
Nature	<b><i>Sustainable tourism development in the Sinjavina Mountain region</i></b>	10	14,420	The development of outdoor activities in the almost completely untapped area of the Sinjavina Mountain would greatly affect the quality of life of the local population. Hence, the project aims to develop and promote activities such as cross-country skiing, hiking, snowshoeing, horseback riding, animal watching and cycling.
Hunting society Pljevlja	<b><i>Hunting education</i></b>	10	13,978	With this project, the Hunting Association of Pljevlja tries to break prejudices about hunters and stress their work regarding the protection of wild game and their habitats. The intention is primarily to set up an educational centre where workshops for young people will be held on the topics like: hunting legislation and hunting ethics, outdoor orienteering, identifying wildlife tracks, dangers while in the forest, and environmental preservation.
Felis Lynx	<b><i>Affirmation and promotion of sports climbing in Kolašin Municipality</i></b>	6	4,920	The municipality of Kolašin offers extraordinary opportunities for sports and recreation and this project seeks to further improve that offer by promoting sport climbing. The activities include the reconstruction and adaptation of the climbing area in Biočinovići to make the site completely safe and suitable for beginners, followed by training for locals and tourists alike.

Natura Nordica	<b><i>Green Action Ulotina</i></b>	5	4,955	The access to the Lim River in the village of Ulotina in Andrijevica region has been blocked for years due to overgrown bushes and a large amount of garbage in the nearby stream; hence, the project aims for cleaning and landscaping, and placing a mounting platform on the river bank.
Sjeverna zemlja (the Northern Land)	<b><i>Touristic and cultural route Berana</i></b>	10	15,081	Berana's tourist offer has not been developed or promoted to the extent that the preserved natural resources and rich cultural heritage deserve. NGO Sjeverna zemlja improves the network of local tourism actors and provides education and promotion of local travel agencies, as well as service providers, and their rich offer and potentials of Berane.
Association of Pensioners Andrijevica	<b><i>Pensioners of Andrijevica</i></b>	10	18,779	Organising different cultural, sport and recreational activities, and creating socialising events for members of the Pensioner's Club in Andrijevica, will improve the quality of life for senior citizens in Andrijevica. Special focus is on services which will add value to leisure activities for people with disabilities and introduce quality content for women members.
Centre of Eco Initiatives	<b><i>Support to young people in agriculture - PROAGRO</i></b>	10	17,211	Through training for young people in agriculture, purchasing equipment, promoting self-employment in agriculture, mentoring and rewarding the best agribusiness ideas, the project of the Centre for Eco Initiatives will help improve the employability of youth in the sector of agriculture.
Crnogorska iskra (Montenegrin spark)	<b><i>Improving social inclusion</i></b>	8	19,592	This is an initiative to introduce a new social and child protection service "Family Outreach Worker" in the municipalities of Berane and Andrijevica. Professionals who will work with families at risk will improve conditions for quality child development and functioning in the family environment.

Following the guidelines of the Centre for Social Work in Nikšić, beneficiaries will have the opportunity to attend training to improve their English language and computer skills, as well as attend training for passing the driving test.
Korina Association	<b><i>Responsibility above all #OPS2023</i></b>	7	17,270	The problem of the uncontrolled population of abandoned dogs in Nikšić represents a health, financial and aesthetic problem. Therefore, the general goal to which the project wishes to contribute is to reduce the number of abandoned dogs in a humane and systematic way and to improve the health of dogs in the territory of the municipality of Nikšić.
Young Ecologist Society, Nikšić & Wild beauty, Plužine	<b><i>Better understanding of waters as a result of climate change</i></b>	10	16,703	The territories of Nikšić and Plužine municipalities are characterised by specific geomorphological and hydrological features, where the available information indicates that in future climate change will significantly affect this area. The general project goal is to help empower local communities to actively influence water conservation due to climate change threat.
Mosaic	<b><i>ADAPT to EMPOWER</i></b>	9	17,871	The "ADAPT to EMPOWER" project will provide innovative services of psychosocial and legal support for people with disabilities from the territory of the municipality of Nikšić, as well as for their families, with outreach teams and targeted support for women with disabilities.

Centre for affirmation of RE population - CAREP	<b><i>Young, brave and loud!</i></b>	10	16,126	The project seeks to address the problem of low involvement of young people from RE community in sports and cultural activities. Activities like scout camps and workshops for high school students on social participation, youth internships, producing Podcasts and diverse educational games, will improve the quality of life of this vulnerable group and encourage young people to get engaged in decision-making processes.
Impulse	<b><i>For an equitable society</i></b>	9	15,269	All research and experiences show that children from the RE community stand less chance to gain basic reading and numerical skills compared to the national average. In this regard, the project includes different activities which will focus on providing remedial teaching to children from vulnerable groups to acquire writing skills.
Business Centre and NGO Mozaik	<b><i>ReWork</i></b>	10	17,860	The project's key component is the inclusion of vulnerable groups in the local labour market. Social protection beneficiaries, people with disabilities, long-term unemployed and members of the RE population will undergo ten months of practical work in order to improve their work-related skills. The project also includes working with businesses to identify opportunities for the development of innovative infrastructure and effective utilisation of human resources, provided for by smart specialization.
Association for assistance to persons with psychophysical disabilities	<b><i>Early intervention for children with developmental disabilities</i></b>	10	19,858	Improving the overall condition and development of children with disabilities and developmental difficulties from Nikšić is the main goal of this project, through early intervention and empowerment of parents. Personalised plans will be created for the fifteen children involved, which include workshops with experts who will work with children to improve their overall psychophysical condition, and communication, motor and social skills.
Alfa Centre	<b><i>Improving cyber security - What is (not) violence</i></b>	8	13,831	To prevent increasingly pronounced cyber violence, the project proposal seeks to improve the capacities of young people to recognize various cyber threats (peer online violence, unsafe sharing of information and passwords, untimely recognition of harmful programmes and distribution of inappropriate content).

Creative Women of Montenegro	<b><i>With European music through Montenegrin cultural diplomacy</i></b>	5	4,995	The revitalisation of cultural heritage through the performance of lesser-known compositions is a key segment of this project. The activities are focused on the "revival" of music artefacts preserved in the funds of the National Museum in Cetinje, which are rarely or never performed. This addresses the challenge of the lack of research on musical heritage in Montenegro, but also enriches the cultural offer of the Old Royal Capital.
Organisation of the Blind for Podgorica, Danilovgrad and Kolašin	<b><i>Supporting accessible primary education for visually impaired students</i></b>	8	11,749	The project aims to improve right on accessible education in Montenegro by printing textbooks in Braille, enlarged black print and audio format. This is of great importance for visually impaired students to facilitate their learning in classroom environment.
Centre for Climate Change, Natural Resources and Energy	<b><i>Network for sustainable and circular textile</i></b>	9	12,485	Young people are prone to fast-changing street fashion trends that come with an extremely high environmental cost. In this regard, over nine months the project will educate young people about their role in the fight against this type of pollution and opportunities for green business in the field of sustainable textiles and strengthen the civil society for active participation in developing policies in the area of circular economy.
Multimedia studio EHO	<b><i>Re- create!</i></b>	5	4,778	Citizens of Danilovgrad will partake in educational and creative workshops to create artistic products from recyclables and recycled material, such as sculpture and multimedia content, which will ultimately be presented to the public. The project will help educate the wider public about the circular economy, by creating multimedia content.
Climatron	<b><i>My world of eco-recycling</i></b>	5	4,995	Waste disposal in cities is a big challenge today, and this project promotes innovative methods of recycling in the Capital City. First of all, it focuses on the education of preschool students to ensure the long-term goal and increase awareness of the importance of proper waste sorting.

Legal Centre	<b><i>Digitally education and legal support for RE children – DigiLaw</i></b>	8	14,516	The project DigiLaw was designed with the aim of encouraging Roma and Egyptian families in Podgorica to put their children through school. In this regard, the project will provide legal help to families with unresolved legal status or poor financial standing in Montenegro, as a result of which their children are not enrolled in school or drop out prematurely.
Ensemble ORO and the Alliance of the Blind	<b><i>Let's unite to revive cultural heritage</i></b>	8	14,400	Along with the research and interpretation of the local musical and ethno-choreological heritage, this project will include people with visual impairments, who are generally not provided with equal participation in the cultural life of the local community, in the production of content. The project will end with rich cultural and artistic events in Podgorica and Danilovgrad.
Independent theatre scene BUNT	<b><i>ARTBIZ</i></b>	5	4,866	The local labour market for artists is quite limited, with young artists often having difficulties with securing their livelihoods. The project offers education to young artists to develop their entrepreneurial skills, and information about all available national and international funds and calls for proposals.
European Policy Network MASTER	<b><i>On to work - Let's go to the EU!</i></b>	10	14,390	The project is designed so as to get young people interested in entrepreneurship, to inform them about the possibilities for production and financing, and encourage them to develop own business skills. Special focus is on vulnerable young people.
Montenegrin alliance for technical culture POLYTECHNIC and Montenegrobotics	<b><i>PG STEM Lab – Modern technologies for young people</i></b>	8	12,230	The mainstay of the project is the organisation of weekend workshops where young people will gain new knowledge in the field of robotics, electronics and 3D printing, as well as the reconstruction of the laboratory, to serve as a modernised work space. This addresses the challenge of the lack of places where young people can do research and share knowledge outside of formal educational institutions. Young people will be additionally stimulated to engage in modern information technologies.

Applied behaviour analysis for children with autism	<b><i>Preparation of children with autism for school</i></b>	5	4,195	There is a lack of professional staff, a lack of educational materials for people who work with children with behavioural changes from the autism spectrum, and a lack of modern didactic methods and treatments, and children often experience going to school as traumatic. This project will prepare all parties involved for this important change and make everyday life easier.
Centre for Children's Rights	<b><i>Economic empowerment of individuals / family members in crisis</i></b>	7	14,985	To reduce the unemployment rate, it is crucial to target the most vulnerable groups - namely minorities, women, people with a lower level of education, senior citizens, single mothers, recipients of social benefits... This project involves working with breadwinners, who will attend workshops to develop motivation, followed by specific skills that will help them in self-employment.
				<b><i>Coastal Mates (Budva, Kotor, Herceg Novi)</i></b>
Ecological Centre Delfin	<b><i>Eco knowledge for active action</i></b>	10	19,635	Contribution to achieving sustainable development goals will be given through education in four primary schools in the Kotor area (by conducting workshops, visiting the project area and by participating in art competition, eco quiz, media campaign to reduce the use of plastic bags, and landscaping and greening of public spaces).
Mare Mare	<b><i>Made by Novljanke</i></b>	8	16,540	"Made by Novljanke" helps women from vulnerable groups to start their business involving sewing. During the project, dozens of sewing workshops will be organized, as well as lectures on starting a business for at least ten participants. Through the development of a Product Catalogue, this initiative will also link them with the companies that will purchase their products.
Society for Cultural Development "Bauo"	<b><i>Knowledge is COOLtura! Increase professional competence of young people in culture</i></b>	10	16,540	During formal education, young people generally do not acquire enough knowledge and skills that can help them get a job in the field of culture. Experiences show that they do not have competences such as writing project applications, fundraising, financial literacy, starting their own business, digital literacy and the like, which is the gap that this project seeks to fill.
