## Development Challenges

Despite efforts from states, the security environment in the West African region continues to deteriorate. Terrorism and insecurity continue to spread, devastating the lives of millions of people. Civilians are often the primary victims of terrorist acts and the suffering and casualties they experience at the hands of terrorist groups is unprecedented. This deteriorating security context has prompted countries like Togo to take measures by strengthening their security and military capabilities to deal with the threats. It is in this context that for several years, Togo has been actively involved in peacekeeping missions in Africa, contributing to the regional stabilization which is a key factor for the development of the sub-region and the African continent.

## Project Objectives

This project aims to provide Togo's Peacekeeping Operations Training Center (CEOMP) with additional capacities to train troops for pre-deployment to peacekeeping missions.

Specifically, the project will increase the material and logistical capacities of the CEOMP and strengthen the technical capabilities of the military and police personnel of pre-deployment troops so that they can protect themselves and the population from attacks by extremist groups.

## Project Outputs

The technical and tactical capabilities of the troops deployed by the peacekeeping training center are strengthened.

CEOMP is equipped with material and logistical capabilities & equipment to strengthen the full operating capacity of the center.
