## ANNEX B: FULLY-COSTED EVALUATION PLAN

In line with the new monitoring, evaluation, and learning (MEL) framework, evaluations will consider: a) *accountability* indicators to mark progress against the UNSDCF, country programme results and resources framework; b) *system level* indicators to monitor overall system dynamics beyond those associated directly but would have impact on UNDP's interventions and the programme hypotheses; and c) *learning* indicators to extract new information and insights on emerging uncertainties and trends that will feed into the portfolios iterative programming approach.

The evaluation plan includes the required evaluations in compliance with UNDP evaluation guidelines and three strategic level evaluations, as following: 1) projects with budget threshold requiring either mid-term and/or final evaluations; 2) projects with duration exceeding five years; 3) projects entering next phase; and 4) GEF/GCF-funded projects. The strategic level evaluation consists of three portfolios namely Circular Economy portfolio, Youth portfolio, and another portfolio yet to be defined and an Independent Country Programme Evaluation (ICPE) during the last year of the programming cycle.

Evaluations are planned during the first three years of country programme implementation to allow enough time for the uptake of lessons learned and recommendations by projects and for adjusting the programmatic approach upon need during the remaining period of the CPD cycle.

UNDP Cambodia will actively contribute to UNSDCF evaluation, jointly with other UN agencies. The evaluation plan will be reviewed yearly to include any new project evaluations and/or other types of evaluation.
