

# **2023 CLUSTER MEETING**

INNOVATE, ACCELERATE, ELEVATE:
POWERING UNDP'S MOONSHOT JOURNEY



## **BACKGROUND**

The 2023 RBA Cluster Meeting is being convened midway through the SDGs and the UNDP Strategic Plan. This is an opportune time to reflect on progress to date and strategize on how best the Bureau could reposition itself to attain the UNDP moonshots in the coming years. This is also a time of significant geostrategic shifts and planetary pressures that are reshaping Africa's development landscape, both conceptually and programmatically, and creating new opportunities for Africa's abundant human and financial resources to lift millions out of poverty. Furthermore, the urgent need to bridge the continent's yawning development financing gap is increasingly evident.

RBA's resident representatives (RRs), Deputy Resident Representatives (DRRs), Hub Chiefs and bureau leadership are being challenged to co-create innovative approaches that would use foresight and technology to reclaim Africa's development space, and position UNDP as Africa's development partner of choice through insightful thought-leadership, evidence-driven programming and effective partnerships.

## **PLANNING**

The agenda for the Cluster Meeting is the product of specific guidance from the Regional Director, consultation within UNDP, a survey of RRs and DRRs (June 2023), a focused online Indaba during which RRs and DRRs discussed five questions arising from the survey (August/September 2023), and insights from the RBA Cluster Meeting planning committee.

## **OBJECTIVES**

A key message from the 2023 June survey is that crowded agendas, successive panels, long days, echo chambers, and the lack of a coherent focus never work. The survey also highlighted the importance of networking – especially for and with new RRs and DRRs and recommended that future Cluster Meetings are more cerebral, interactive and include dialogue with global/regional thought leaders.

Consequently, the agenda for the 2023 Cluster Meeting has four main objectives.

## **OUTLINE**

The agenda for the 2023 Cluster Meeting includes: **7 learning sessions**, **6 spotlight dialogues**, **6 ideation sessions**, **3 teamwork sessions** and **2 high-level dialogue sessions**.

#### LEARNING SESSIONS:

These panels allow attendees to learn from each other and from RBA leadership. The intent is to communicate sound practice and focus on impact.

#### SPOTLIGHT SESSIONS:

These panels feature high-level global thought-leaders. The intent is to bring fresh thinking, while allowing attendees to interrogate ideas and approaches.

#### IDEATION SESSIONS:

These mainly group sessions challenge attendees to unpack complex issues and co-create innovative and practical responses. These sessions will be tech-enabled using relevant software and techniques.

#### TEAMWORK SESSIONS:

These sessions highlight how attendees could leverage UNDP-wide assets, and learn from other UNDP regional bureaus.

#### SOCIAL SESSIONS:

These cultural, networking and recreational opportunities provide much-needed balance and facilitate effective team-building.
