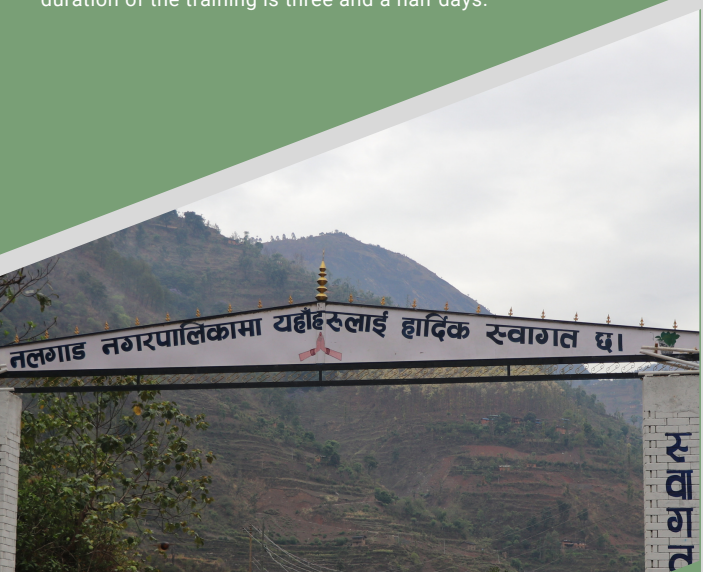


ABOUT

This training is a part of the project titled 'Enhancing Human Security through Local Climate Actions' which is funded by the Government of Japan and implemented by UNDP in Barekot Rural Municipality and Nalgad Municipality, Jajarkot District, Karnali Province, Nepal.

It is aimed at **building the capacity of the local elected representatives and policy-makers** for improved understanding of the human security concept and integrating it into planning, budgeting and implementation activities.

It has **five modules** delivered through various tools such as presentations, group discussions and consultations. The duration of the training is three and a half days.



KEY CONTENTS

MODULE 1

CONCEPT OF HUMAN SECURITY



It introduces the concept of human security, its major components, their inter-linkages and the key drivers of human insecurity especially in the local context.

MODULE 2

IMPACTS OF CLIMATE CHANGE ON HUMAN SECURITY



It aims to demonstrate the ways in which climate change can impact the human security of the local areas such as biodiversity loss, implications on agriculture and income security.

MODULE 3

ASSESSING CLIMATE CHANGE INDUCED HUMAN SECURITY RISKS



It aims to equip the participants with relevant skills to leverage existing tools such as Local Adaptation Plan of Action, census data, health surveys to develop data-driven strategies and policies to mitigate and adapt to climate-induced risks to human security.

MODULE 4

IMPROVING HUMAN SECURITY THROUGH KEY SECTORAL INTERVENTION



It aims to provide the participants ways to improve human security in the key sectors of healthcare, education, economic security, food security, water and sanitation, environmental security and personal security.

MODULE 5

INTEGRATING HUMAN SECURITY INTO LOCAL PLANNING AND BUDGETING



It aims to acquaint the participants with an understanding of aspects like needs assessment, capacity building, data collection, monitoring, cross-sector collaboration, and inclusion to help integrate human security into local planning and budgeting.

To improve the understanding of human security, its components and its linkages with climate-induced risks.



To enhance the capacity of the elected representatives and municipal officials to improve human security by leveraging local development plans.



To develop strategies for improving human security in key sectors including health, education, agriculture, infrastructure and local development.
