Analytics and Problem Identification Solution Creation and Accompaniment Policy, Strategy and Procedural Innovation



The Lab surveys and analyses the delivery metrics of the country office and identifies more efficient ways of enhancing delivery.



The Lab provides actual solutions and implements them through the Lab's experts and Crisis Bureau deployment mechanisms.

Based on lessons learned in COs the Lab guides the organization in identifying, prioritizing, adopting, and implementing a series of policy, strategy, systems, and procedural changes.


