TERMS OF REFERENCE

Website Development for The Enhancing Climate Change Adaptation in the North Coast and Nile Delta Regions in Egypt Project (ECCADP)

1 Background

The Enhancing Climate Change Adaptation in the North Coast and Nile Delta Regions in Egypt Project (ECCADP) aims at supporting the adaptation efforts of Egypt in the North coast and in particular the Nile Delta which is identified by the IPCC in its Fourth Assessment Report as one of the world's three "extreme" vulnerable. The objective of the project is to reduce coastal flooding risks in Egypt's North Coast due to the combination of projected sea level rise and more frequent and intense extreme storm events. Output 1 focuses on constructing 69 km of sand dune dikes at five vulnerable hotspots within the Nile Delta that were identified during an engineering scoping assessment and technical feasibility study. Output 2 focuses on the development of an Integrated Coastal Zone Management (ICZM) plan for the entire North Coast, to manage long-term climate change risks and provide Egypt with adaptability to impending flood risks. The project will facilitate transformational change in the shortterm by reducing coastal flooding threats along vulnerable hotspots in the Delta and in the long-term by integrating additional risks of climate change into coastal management and planning, budgeting and implementation of risk reduction measures. The Project is implemented by the Ministry of Water Resources and Irrigation in collaboration with UNDP and is funded from the Green Climate Fund (GCF). The project is managed by a Project Management Unit (PMU) which is led by the executive project manager and includes staff assisting the manager in carrying the various management tasks. The project seeks a firm with relevant expertise to upgrade the existing project website and its functionality.

2 Objective of the Assignment

The overall objectives of the assignment are to upgrade the design of the existing website for the ECCADP project to help disseminate and communicate information on the entire activities of the project, as well as to keep the project audience with latest news, upcoming activities and programmers of all its components at the national and local levels.

The Specific objective of the contractor is to manage a process for identifying the best possible architecture to upgrade the ECCADP website.

3 Scope of the Assignment

The ECCADP web site upgrade proposes can be structured into:

- 1) Needs assessment (2 week)
- 2) Development and Deployment
 - Website Design of the upgrade and Development (6 weeks)
 - Testing (2 weeks)
 - Beta Release (1 week)
 - Deployment
- 3) Staff Training for CMS & handover (1 week)
- 4) Maintenance & Support Services









Subsequent sections detail out the guideline, deliverables & timelines applicable to each of these phases.

The firm undertaking the assignment shall be expected to adopt all necessary measures (agile development methodologies, parallel work streams etc.) to ensure strict timely delivery of deliverables & outcomes for each of these phases.

3.1. Needs Assessment

3.1.1. Overview

Overview Prior to initiating the upgrade and development process, the firm shall be required to, in consultation with the ECCADP project team, establish specifically the functional and technical scope of work. This process shall be carried out in order to ensure clarity and all-round understanding of the assignment goals and end-deliverables. Specifically, this phase will involve confirming audiences, objectives, graphic look and feel, navigation, technology issues and assumptions, required functionality, phasing, and budgetary constraints. It is also expected that the firm will provide a detailed assignment plan to assist the internal ECCADP project team in better managing handover of any formats, content and other information that will be required at different stages of the subsequent design, development and deployment phases.

3.1.2. Timeline & Deliverables

3.2.1.3. Technical Guidelines & Specifications

3.3. Staff Training & Documentation Handover

3.3.1. Deliverables & Timelines

The firm will be expected to provide within 1 week of the live deployment of the website, the following:

 All the necessary documentation stating the configuration options of the website, and a training manual (with snap shots) that covers key processes that are the responsibility of internal ECCADP staff – using cPanel to modify website content, accessing & interpreting reports, escalation procedures in case of downtime.

Onsite training support to key identified ECCADP staff with basic administration interfaces, understanding analytic reports and cPanel use & procedures with regards to adding any dynamic content to the website – events, files, blogs, articles etc.

3.4. Website Warranty and Maintenance

The firm will be expected to provide a warranty of **3 months** (including bug fixes, updates, or change requests) followed by **9 months** of maintenance & support services, after live deployment of the website. The specific elements of the maintenance are expected to be as follows:

- 1. Offsite Support: Provide services with regards to modifying existing sections of the website, making layout changes, fixing bugs or making updates, as per service levels set with the internal project team at the needs assessment phase. This could include additional features to the website.
 - The firm should specify an hourly rate for human resource (programmers, designers, project managers etc.) which will be provided for any further additions/modifications on the website for the duration of the maintenance period.
- 2. Content Uploading: The firm shall provide training to the ECCADP staff on managing the cPanel and uploading all types of content to the website. The firm will also undertake to upload any content when requested by the ECCADP project team for the duration of the maintenance period, and content must be uploaded within 4 hours.
- 3. Backups & Server Maintenance: Provide regular backups of all website data, with service levels of restoring data in case of server crash or downtime.
