Project theory of change

- <u>IF</u> young men and women, have better access to quality, credible information that will increase their capacity for analysis and discernment, as well as a space to make their voices heard;
- IF the Malagasy media sector is strengthened in its ability to broadcast unbiased, neutral and professional content, and provides a framework for dialogue between different socioprofessional, gender and intergenerational strata through quality radio programs that address the concerns of local populations, particularly the most vulnerable young people;
- <u>THEN</u>, young people will be able to play a greater part in the peaceful resolution of conflicts and in the democratic and development process,
- And the media sector will help to rebuild the social network, reduce marginalization and promote peaceful coexistence, not least by giving young people a better place.



Prospects

- Application for a radio operating license for the capital Antananarivo (and extension to two other regions)
- Increasing the number of partner radio stations: in districts where there is no community radio station, through the National Radio antenna.
- Staff stability: permanent contracts
- Construction of a building for the NGO Studio Sifaka
- Operationalization of the iVERIFY system (fight against misinformation)
