



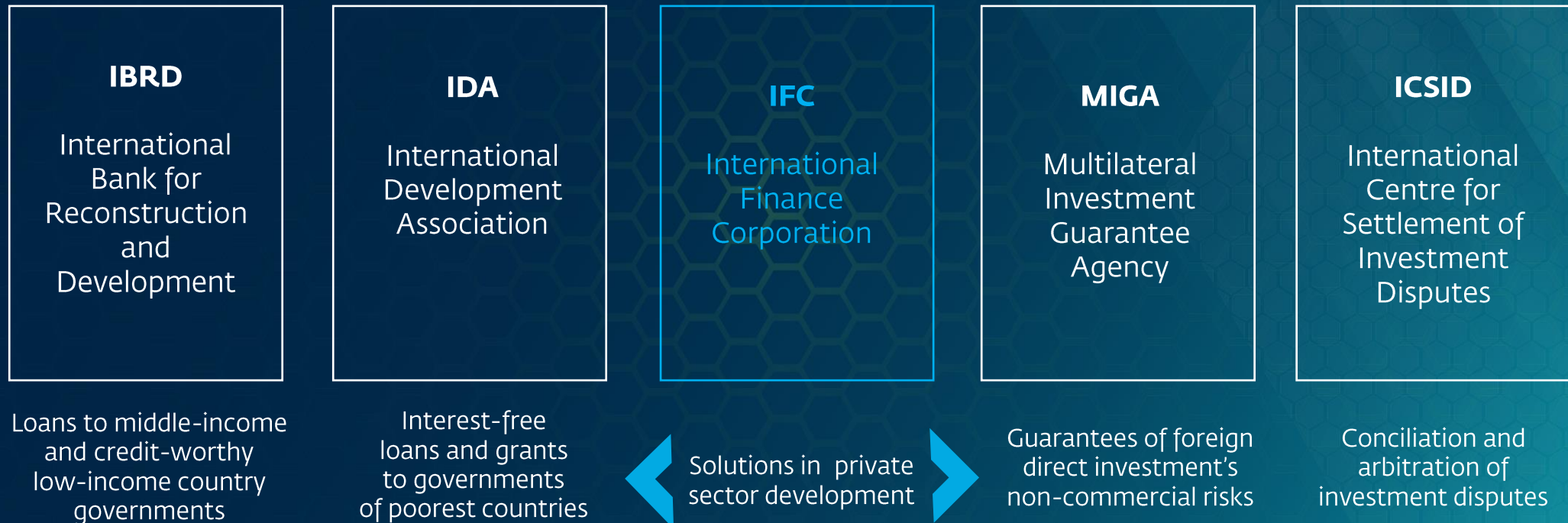

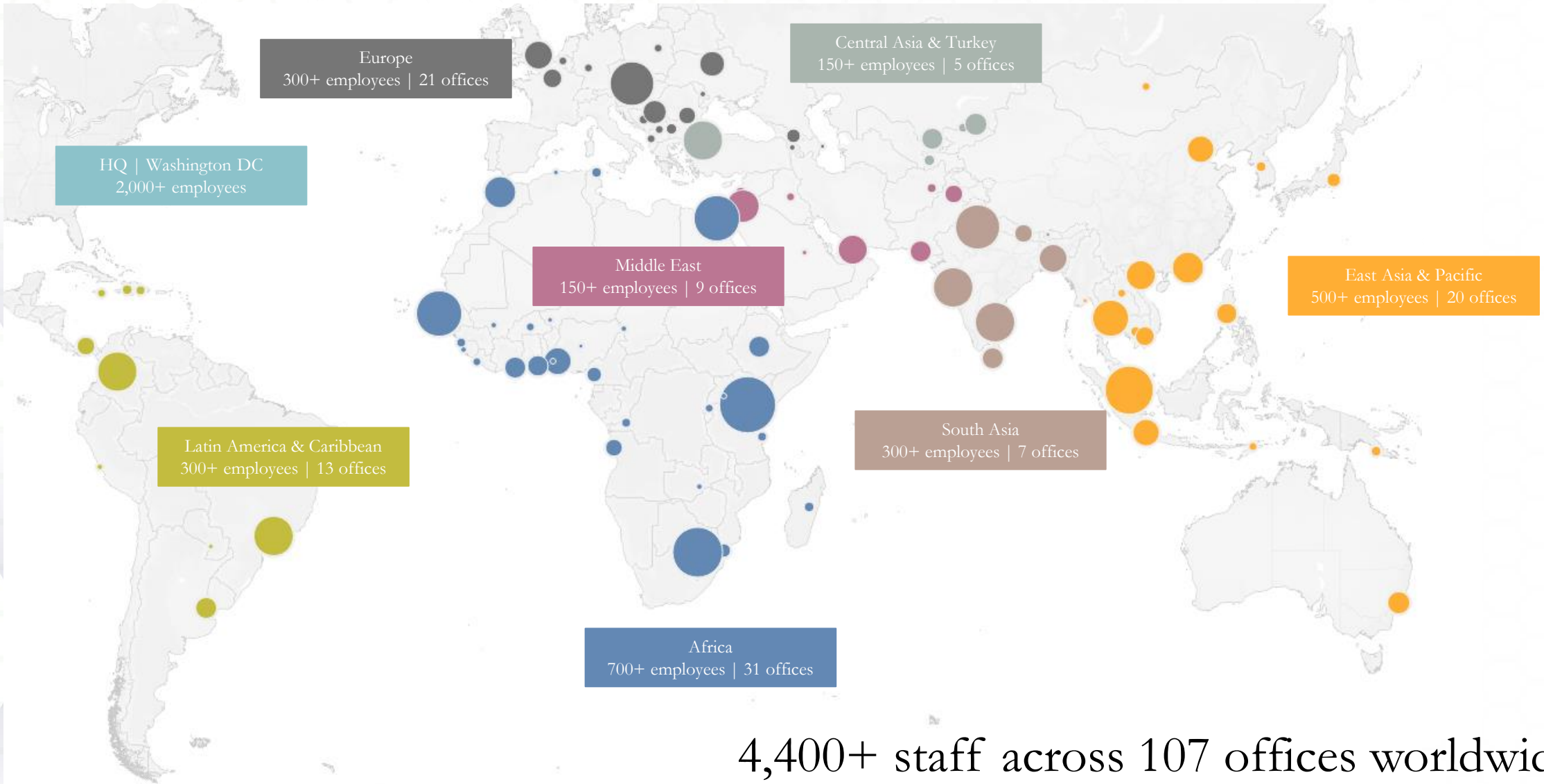

IFC PERFORMANCE STANDARDS



- IFC is an ESG standard-setter, helping redirect capital in supporting the SDGs.
- Through the Equator Principles, the PSs have been embraced by 128 banks from 38 countries, covering 70% of global project finance.
- IFC’s ESG standards align with 16 of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals and 30 their underlying targets.

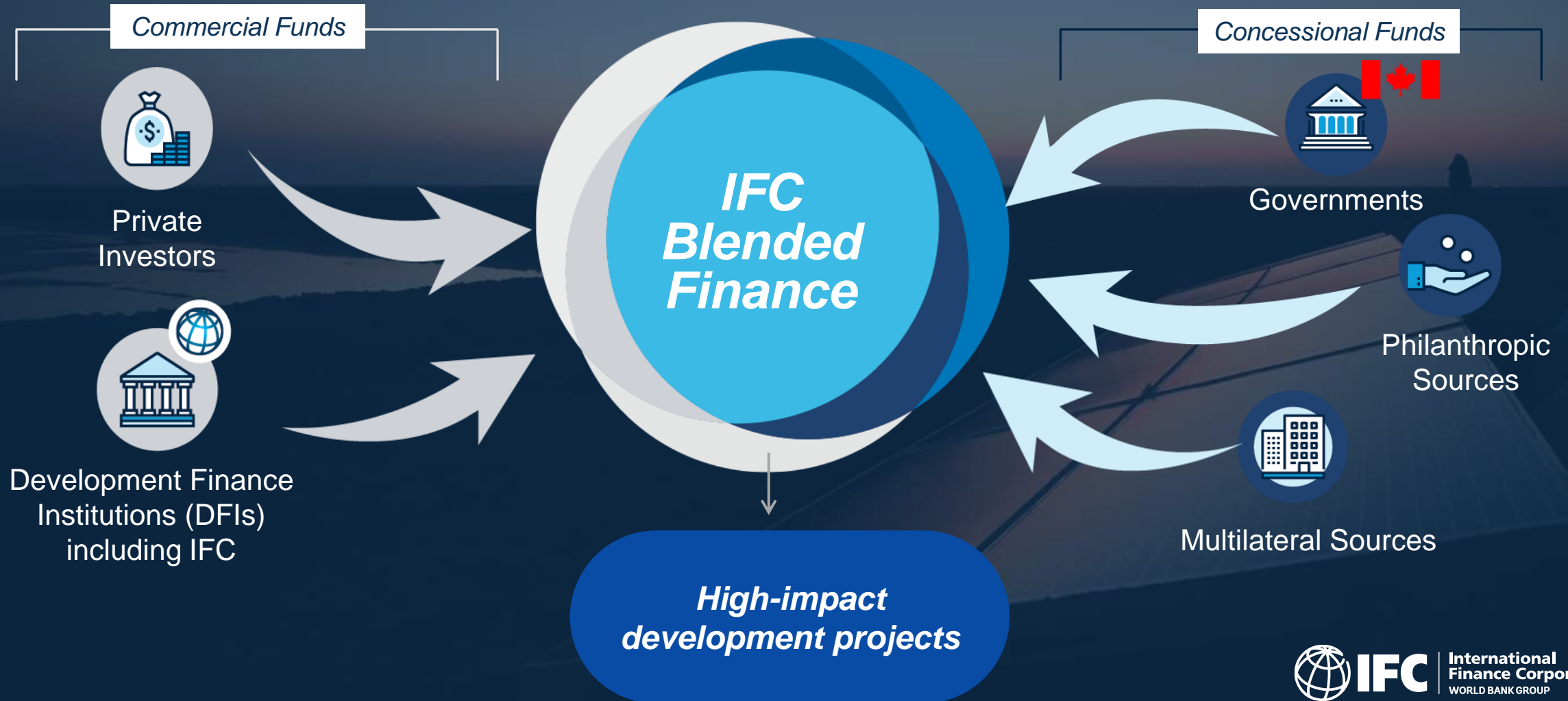

CLIMATE BUSINESS

- IFC's Climate Action Plan is aligned with the WBG's Climate Change Action Plan and delivered from the Paris Agreement.
- IFC to align 85% of all Board-approved projects with the PA starting July 1, 2023 and 100% from July 1 2025.
- IFC to keep its climate finance share to at least 35% during FY25-30.
- All IFC projects to be screened for GHG emissions and climate risks.

BLENDING FINANCE

Blended finance, where concessional funds from partners are blended with IFC's own financing, can support projects with high development impact that are on the threshold of commercial viability but need additional financial support to de-risk or rebalance the risk-return profile to attract private sector investors.
