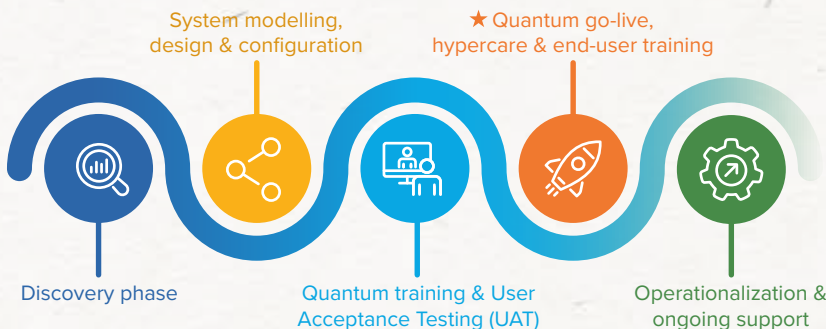

HOW WE IMPLEMENT QUANTUM

Our implementation approach is based on an agile, iterative cloud methodology, allowing us to adapt to your agency's unique needs and evolving requirements. This flexible approach allows us to make continuous improvements and quickly respond to issues. **The typical implementation period ranges from 3 to 18 months**, determined by project scope and the implementation model selected. Below is an overview of the typical implementation process:



COST MODEL & EFFICIENCY OPPORTUNITIES

As a shared platform, Quantum operates on a full cost sharing model. Consortium partners invest in ongoing platform improvements that benefit all partners, as well as individualized components based on their unique priorities. This centralized approach has already led to efficiency gains, enhanced data accuracy, and significant savings in **payroll, procurement, and recruitment processes**.

Estimated Quantum implementation costs are three to six times the annual operating expense. This **ranges from \$400 to \$600 per user annually**. Costs are based on **module selection, required functionality and selected implementation approach**.
