Conflict Prevention and Promotion of Democratic Participation of Women and Vulnerable Populations in Côte d'Ivoire

In Côte d'Ivoire, the democratic landscape faces significant challenges, including low civic engagement, limited political representation of women, weak institutional capacities, and the growing potential for contentious political discourse.

These vulnerabilities have contributed to diminished trust in democratic processes and the heightened risk of political instability and violence. In response, national and local authorities have highlighted the urgent need to preserve a peaceful environment for dialogue, improve citizen participation, and foster inclusive government. This project aims to strengthen the capacities of national institutions and expand training for local officials to ensure transparent, participatory, and peaceful democratic processes.

OBJECTIVES

- **Facilitate** the reinforcement of a political landscape that is united and supportive in its diversity, and where populations embrace “living together” and resolve their differences peacefully
- **Bolster** capacity of staff responsible for social cohesion activities and democratic process management
- **Contribute** to the consolidation of an inclusive and peaceful environment

- Improvement of information distribution and **citizen awareness**
- Enhancement of **communication** strategy
- Strengthening of **police capacities** in charge of security and maintaining order for democratic processes
