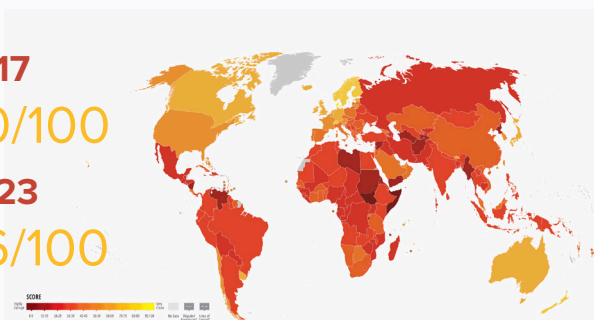

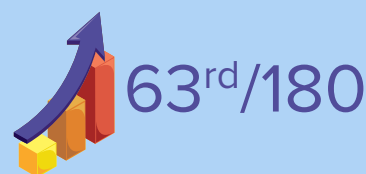
## KUWAIT TRANSPARENCY INTERNATIONAL CORRUPTION PERCEPTION INDEX (CPI)
