
3 SYSTEMIC SHIFTS

Shifts are the desired directions of travel to achieve national ambition.

-  **Shift 1**
Economic diversification, inclusive growth, and human development for resilient growth.
-  **Shift 2**
Climate action and nature-based solutions for growth and human security for resilient growth.
-  **Shift 3**
Strong institutions, civic space, and people-centred digital governance for a peaceful and resilient society for resilient growth.

DYNAMIC PORTFOLIOS

UNDP applies portfolio approach that views development as a collection of interconnected and interdependent elements and actors; leverages the relationships and interactions between them holistically in an interdisciplinary manner to achieve national ambition. A system may be described at multiple levels, namely, the 'whole', a 'part' of the whole, or a 'subset' of the part, depending on complexity and purpose. Resulting portfolios include, for example, Circular Economy, Youth Engagement, and Inclusive Economic Growth.



INTENT STATEMENT

Leverage UNDP's networks of expertise, partnerships, and resources to support the Royal Government to graduate from the Least Developed Country (LDC) status and become an upper middle-income nation by 2030.
