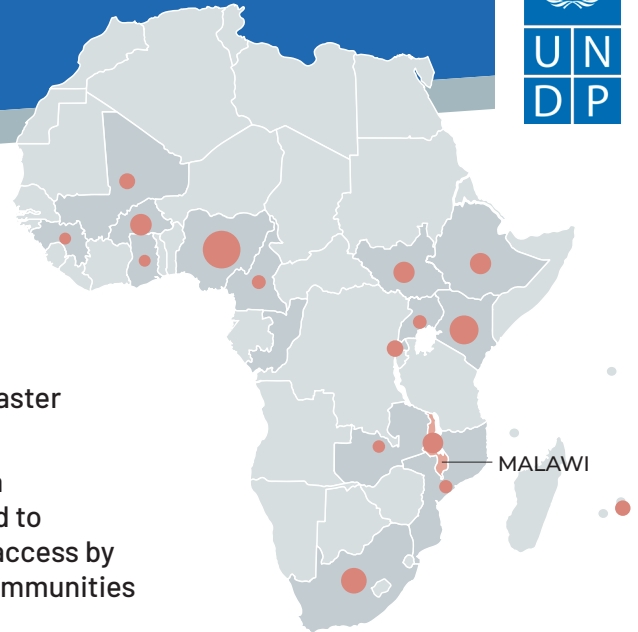


DISASTER RISK REDUCTION



MALAWI

Japan – Malawi – UNDP Partnership for Inclusive Disaster Recovery Project.

Following the impact of Cyclone Idai in March 2019, a partnership between Japan, Malawi and UNDP aimed to support human security through safe and dignified access by the poor to climate-resilient housing for affected communities displaced by the floods from the cyclone.

The Government of Malawi, with support from the Government of Japan and a partnership between the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and the United Nations Office for Disaster Risk Reduction (UNDRR), embarked on the Inclusive Disaster Recovery project.

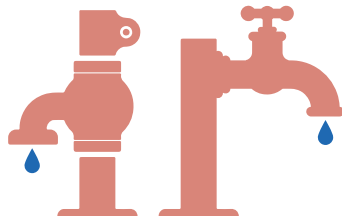
200 households with vulnerable persons including the disabled, the elderly and women and children-headed household benefited.
