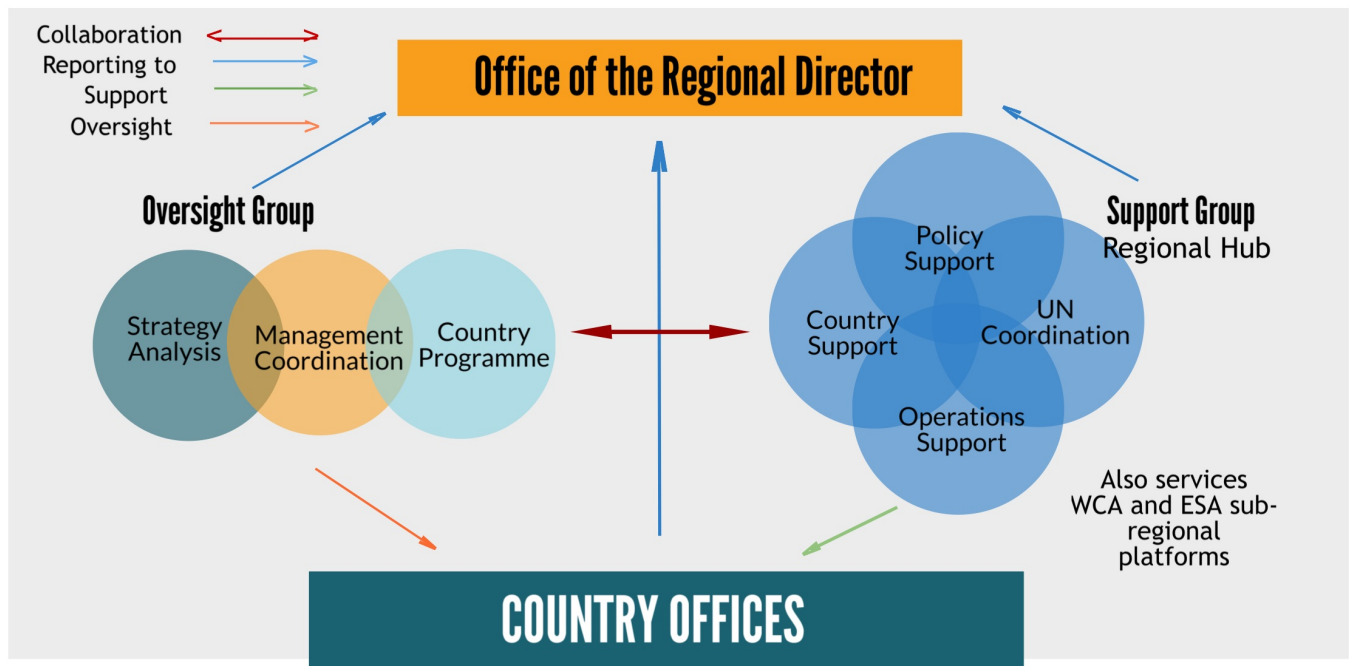




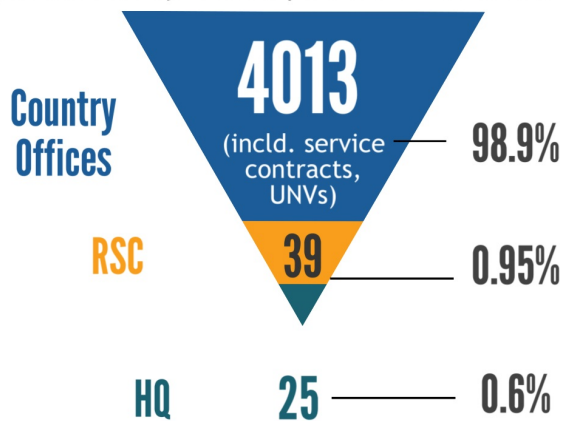
UNDP Africa in 60 seconds

RBA Organizational Chart

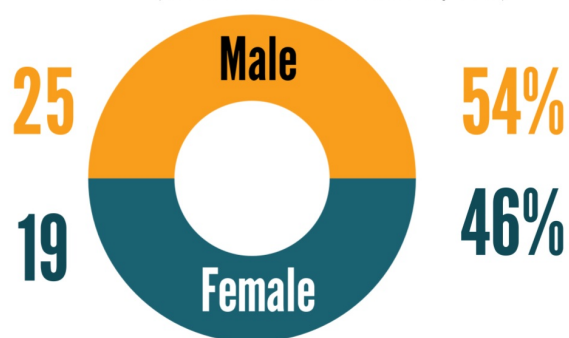


Demographics

Regional Gender Project

Ambitious new project aims to boost youth and women's political participation, empower women economically and increase their productivity in agriculture.

Vulnerable Regions

UNDP now has an integrated strategy for the Sahel region and is planning one for the Great Lakes.

Extractives

UNDP is co-sponsoring the African Mineral Development Centre, providing key advice to governments.

Common African Position on post-2015 Agenda

UNDP-supported Position recognizes trends such as population growth, youth bulge, urbanization, climate change and inequalities. It prioritizes structural transformation.

Regional Programme Document

New programme engages more effectively with African Union and regional economic communities, through the development of long-term strategic partnerships

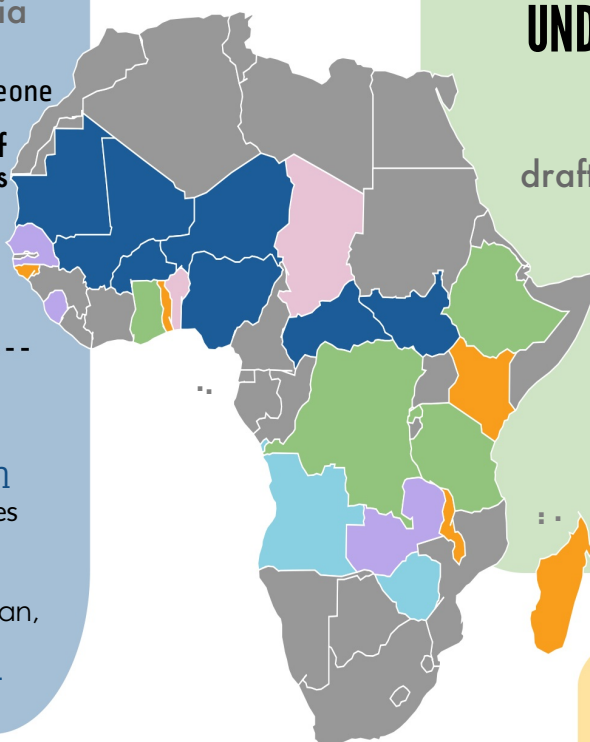

Challenges and Opportunities

Looking ahead, RBA will focus its support on completing the job of the MDGs while preparing to operationalize the Common African Position on the post-2015 Agenda.

1. Strengthen women's empowerment in Africa



Complete the gender seal, bolster the bureau's leadership and promote opportunities for career advancement for women

Reinforce gender programming, esp. in view of AU's Year of Women's Empowerment in 2015.

2. Bolster innovation



Use UNDP's innovation funds and mechanisms to encourage 'business unusual'.

3. Take part in Rights Up Front initiative



Ensure organizational preparedness to prevent human rights and humanitarian crises.

4. Operationalize the Common African Position

Localize and socialize the agenda, monitor national progress, mobilize and engage countries, introduce action plan, support countries to collect data.



5. Strengthen UN Coordination

Support preparation of development results focused UNDAFs (roll-outs to take place in countries over the next three years)
