The UNDP Resilience Hub for Africa, established in Nairobi, Kenya in 2019, is a thematic hub with a mandate on integrated resilience covering the 46 Sub-Saharan countries under UNDP's Regional Bureau for Africa

#### Vision

The Resilience Hub provides thought leadership and cutting-edge support for resilience building in Africa, with the goal of making UNDP's work both future-ready and shockproof by transforming resilience-informed programming into reality.
