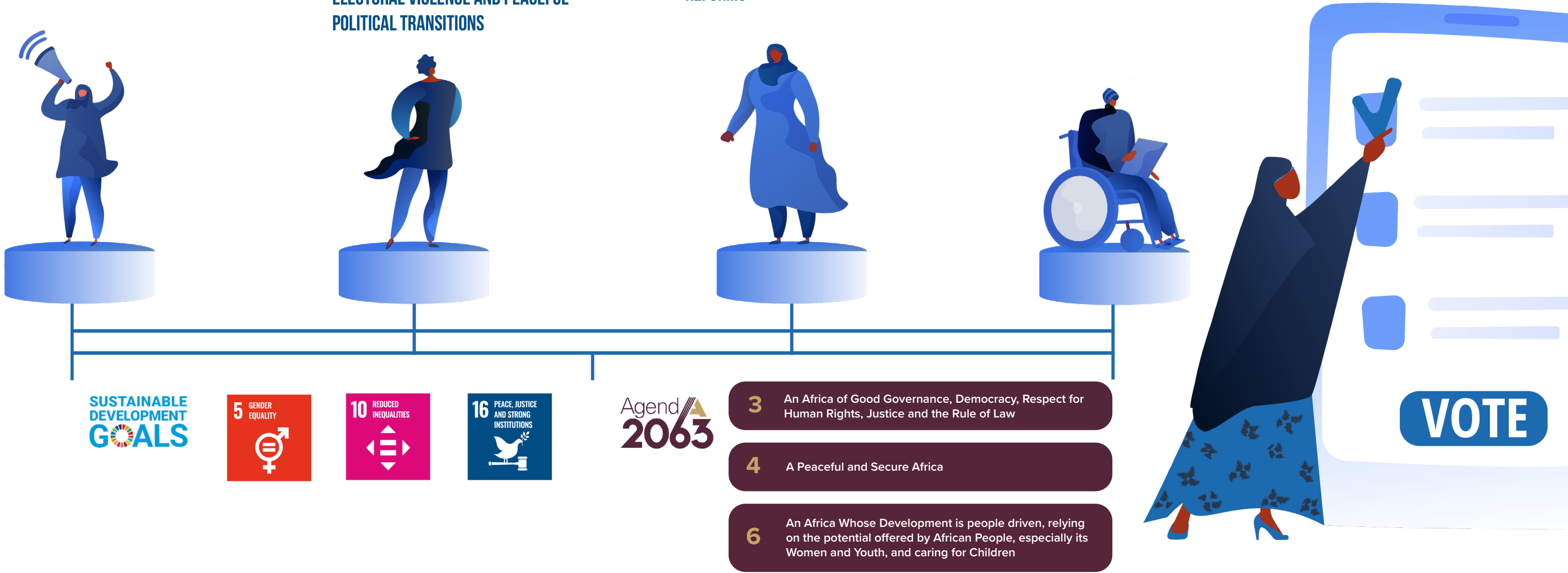

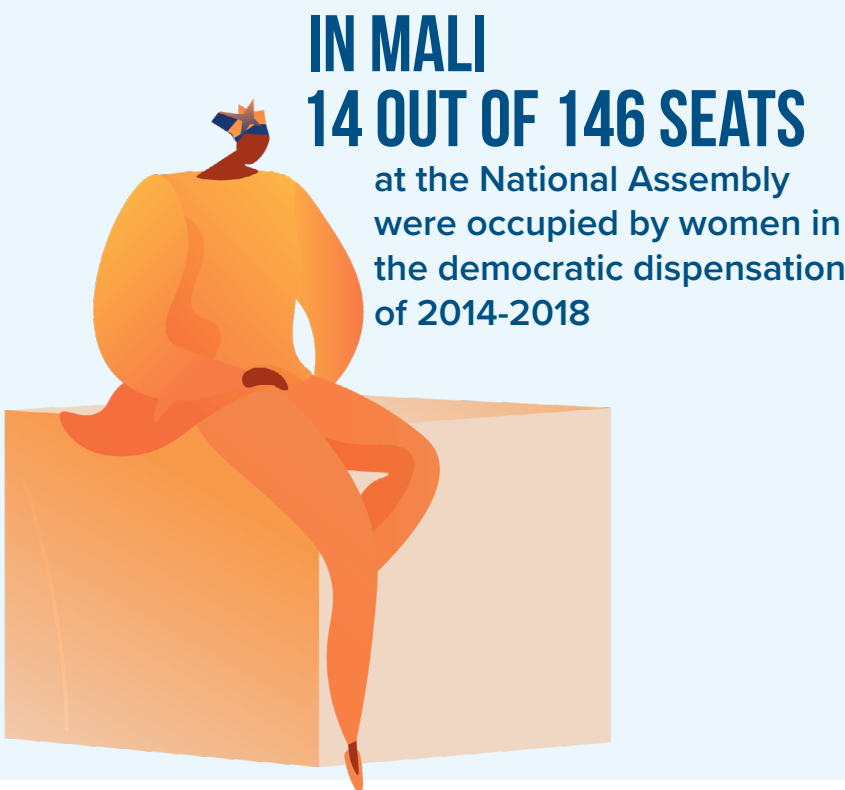
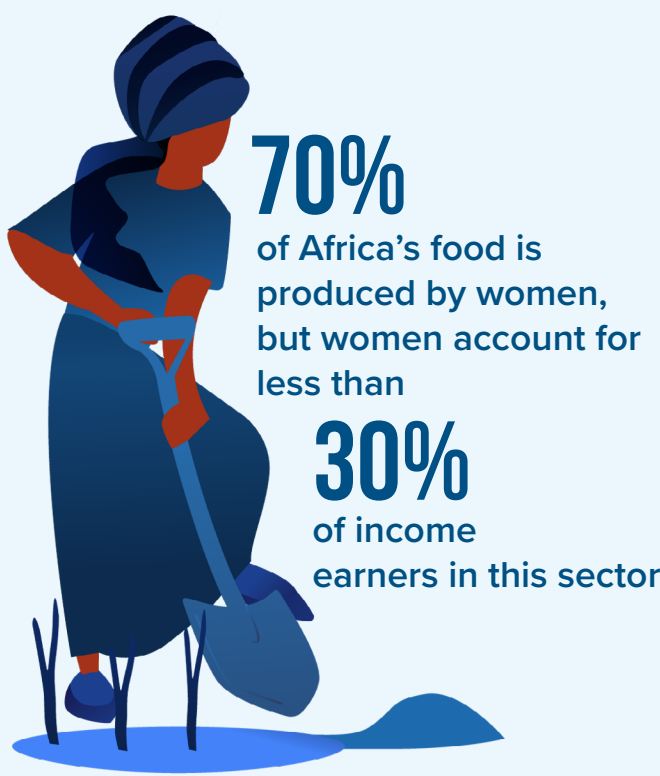


Security, humanitarian and development challenges persist in the Sahel
