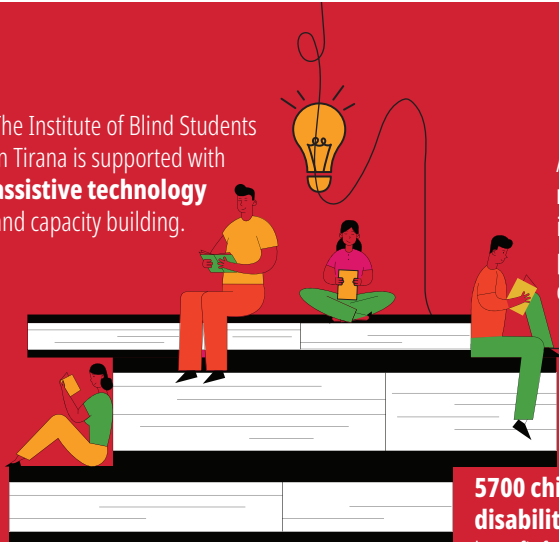

The Institute of Blind Students in Tirana is supported with **assistive technology** and capacity building.

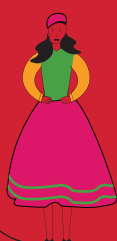


Around **1900 citizens** have created **networks and forums** to voice and influence decision making when it comes to planning and budgeting for provision of social care services for vulnerable groups.

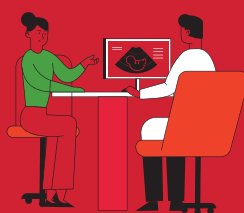
5700 children and youth with disabilities and their family members benefit from improved community based social care services supported by LNB.



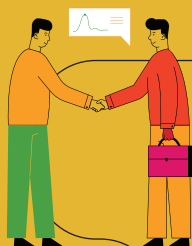
4,900 Roma and Egyptians in 3 partner municipalities benefitted from a tailored package of integrated social services.

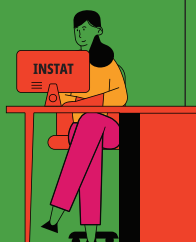
