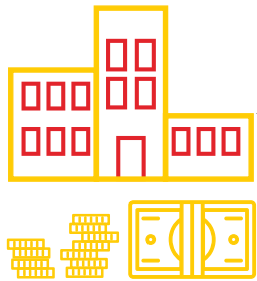

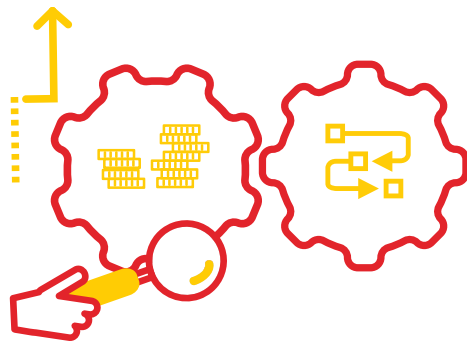
Project aim

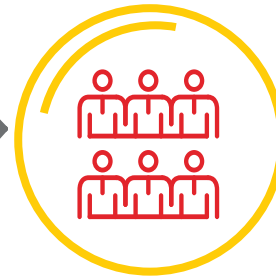

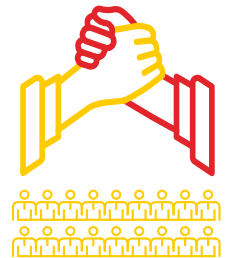

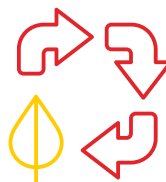
