HIGHLIGHTS FROM INTERNATIONAL/ NATIONAL REPORTS

Relying on the EU for over 75% of its exports and 60% of its imports, Albania is potentially vulnerable to the economic contraction in much of the EU. 9% GDP decline estimated.

COVID-19 outbreak will instigate a recession in the economy, which heavily relies on trade with and investments from the EU. Within the domestic markets SMEs, manufacturing and tourism sectors will be among the most affected.
