We tap into the **collective intelligence and engage local talent** to address the impact of COVID-19: **109 proposals were received** during the digital 'ideathon #covIDEJA' launched with BitAlliance and twenty other partners.

In Canton Sarajevo, we support the **public dashboard that monitors the situation related to COVID-19 and connects health authorities to the information platform**.
