Every Waterdrop Counts! Design Competition

The UNDP in Bosnia and Herzegovina is launching a countrywide Initiative "Every Waterdrop Counts!" which aims to raise awareness about the enormous importance of water and water saving across Bosnia and Herzegovina. Students of all ages from Bosnia and Herzegovina are invited to participate in the **design competition on water saving and illustrate ways to reduce personal water consumption** by sending a copy, scan or picture of their design in high quality to the e-mail address <u>registry.ba@undp.org</u> by December 31, 2020.

The submitted works can be done by using any technique (paintings, drawings, photographs, graphics solution).

The designs should cover one of the following water saving tips:

- 1. Turn off the tap while brushing your teeth!
- 2. Turn off the tap while soaping your hands!
- 3. Take a short shower! / Take a shower instead of a bath!
- 4. Put a full washing load on!
- 5. Fill the dishwater / Use a basket to wash dishes instead of running water!
- 6. Detect and repair water leakages!
- 7. Collect rainwater to water the garden!
- 8. Fill kitchen utensils with water for cooking only as much as needed!
- 9. Use a water-saving device in your toilet cistern.
- 10. Or any other idea how to save water.

Each complete application should contain:

- 1. Name, age, place (city) of residence of the participant, and educational institution.
- 2. Illustrations, i.e. drawings or photographs of the design or graphic solution submitted exclusively in digital JPEG or PDF format, if possible in high resolution.
- 3. If you are underage, parents, teachers or any other relevant person over the age of 18 is asked to submit the work on behalf of the student.

Registration for the competition must be individual and every applicant can only submit one proposal to the competition.

Parents, teachers or any other relevant person can submit the work on behalf of the student.

By participating in this competition, the applicant acknowledges and accepts the rulebook of this competition. The rulebook can be found below.

The works of art will be evaluated in relation to its originality and ability to clearly show the topic that promotes water saving in BiH, and the possibility to use the design to illustrate other UNDP products. The number of likes received on Instagram will also be taken into account.

RULEBOOK FOR REGISTRATION AND PARTICIPATION IN THE DESIGN COMPETITION FOR "EVERY WATERDROP COUNTS!"

Subject

a basis for opening discussion on this topic among young people in the country. The submitted works can be done by using any technique (paintings, drawings, photographs, graphics solution).

Topic

The competition is organized within "Svaka kap vode je bitna" Initiative under the topic "Water saving" The designs should cover one of the following water saving tips:

- 1. Turn off the tap while brushing your teeth!
- 2. Turn off the tap while soaping your hands!
- 3. Take a short shower! / Take a shower instead of a bath!
- 4. Put a full washing load on!
- 5. Fill the dishwater / Use a basket to wash dishes instead of running water!
- 6. Detect and repair water leakages!
- 7. Collect rainwater to water the garden!
- 8. Fill kitchen utensils with water for cooking only as much as needed!
- 9. Use a water-saving device in your toilet cistern.
- 10. Or any other idea how to save water.

The right to participate

The competition is open to all students of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Registration for the competition must be individual.

Application period

The "Every Waterdrop Counts!" Initiative will receive applications for the competition from December 8, 2020 to December 31, 2020, exclusively via the email address registry.ba@undp.org, with a mandatory indication in the subject of the message Design Competition - "Every Waterdrop Counts!".

Content of the application

Each complete application should contain:

- 1. Name, age, place of residence (city) of the participant and educational institution.
- 2. Illustrations, i.e. paintings, drawings, photographs or graphic solution submitted exclusively in digital JPEG or PDF format, if possible in high resolution.
- 3. If you are underage, parents, teachers or any other relevant person over the age of 18 is asked to submit the work on behalf of the student.

Entries must be original and the work of the authors proposing the work. One applicant can submit a maximum of one creative proposal to the competition.

Evaluation criteria

In order to participate, all applications must meet the standards and rules set out in this public call. Applications will be evaluated by a commission (jury) composed of representatives of the "Every Waterdrop Counts!" team and UNDP in BIH. The first-placed design for every saving tip will be awarded. The winning works will be announced no later than January 15, 2021.

Awards

All participants will receive a Certificate of participation in electronic version. The authors of the winning and selected works will receive a package of awards promoting water saving and plastic free waste. Awards will be distributed within 30 working days from the day of the announcement of the winners.

Right of disposal

Every Waterdrop Counts! assumes no responsibility for lost, late, incomplete, or incorrect applications. Applications will not be returned and they become the permanent property of the "Every Waterdrop Counts!" Initiative. By registering for the competition, all participants (all relevant persons over the age of 18) agree that "Every Waterdrop Counts!" has the right to publicly present, copy or otherwise use the submitted works in accordance with the needs of the competition, and agree for the first name and age of the participant to be published together with the work.

Final provisions

The Every Waterdrop Counts! Initiative has the full right to cancel, withdraw and / or correct the competition or any part thereof. Every Waterdrop Counts! has the right to disqualify any application if it considers that it has violated the rules of participation.
