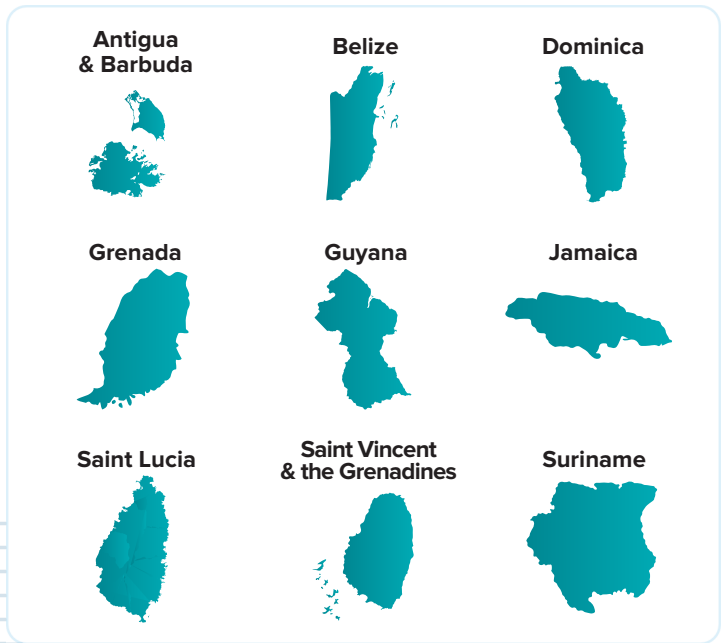


Enabling Gender Responsive Disaster Recovery, Climate and Environmental Resilience in the Caribbean (EnGenDER)

EnGenDER Scope

This project aims to ensure that climate change and disaster risk reduction actions for each of the nine participating Caribbean countries are better informed and steps are taken to ensure that inequalities experienced by persons as a result of system biases due to gender, disability, or age are alleviated rather than made worse. The countries National Adaptation Plans (NAPs) and Nationally Appropriate Mitigation Action (NAMAs) will serve as entry points for promoting and achieving gender responsiveness to climate change and Disaster Risk Resilience.

Gender Responsive Analysis

Support gender machineries for a detailed analysis of gender inequalities of climate risk and its associated costs in the Caribbean

- Conduct country-level reviews on the gender inequality of disaster and climate risk and the cost of inaction
- Effectively communicate gender inequalities
- Strengthen capacities among local stakeholders to implement methodology to measure gender dimensions of risk



Climate Change

Improved climate resilience for women and girls and key vulnerable populations and future generations in the Caribbean

- Conduct the Gender-Responsive Climate Resilience Baseline Analysis
- Conduct Gender-Responsive and Inclusive Budgeted Sectoral Adaptation Strategies and Action Plans (SASAPs)
- Provide training on gender-equality mainstreaming
- Accelerate the closure of existing climate financing gaps through the EnGenDER Offer of Complementary Funding (OCF)



Disaster Recovery

To significantly enhance gender-responsive and inclusive resilient recovery approaches and solutions

- Update the Caribbean Disaster Emergency Management Agency (CDEMA) Model National Recovery Framework.
- Update the Comprehensive Disaster Management (CDM) Audit tool, via an in-country review & analysis of past experiences
- Support national preparedness for gender-responsive recovery
- Conduct targeted training on gender-responsive resilient recovery
- Establish & operationalise the Caribbean Resilience Recovery Facility (CRRF)
- Strengthen linkages between disaster management & social protection



Behavioural Change

Support the implementation of gender-responsive behavioral change strategies

- Conduct analyses of behavioural biases at the national level
- Assess the impact of behavioural change strategies in national decision making processes
- Develop an advocacy strategy for women participation in climate change & disaster recovery
- Implement communication and behavioural change strategies which support gender equality across national decision making mechanisms



COVID-19 Response

Income Support

Income support for the most vulnerable, including female-headed households, persons with disabilities, the elderly and individuals who lost their jobs as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.



Essential Goods and Services

Support to initiatives that facilitate the delivery of essential goods and services, such as food, medicines, personal protective equipment and care services to those who have lost their ability to access the same



Gender-Based Violence

Support to initiatives that tackle Gender-Based Violence and provide direct assistance to victims of gender-based violence, with special emphasis on rural and small communities
