## Study Case : Tesso Nilo

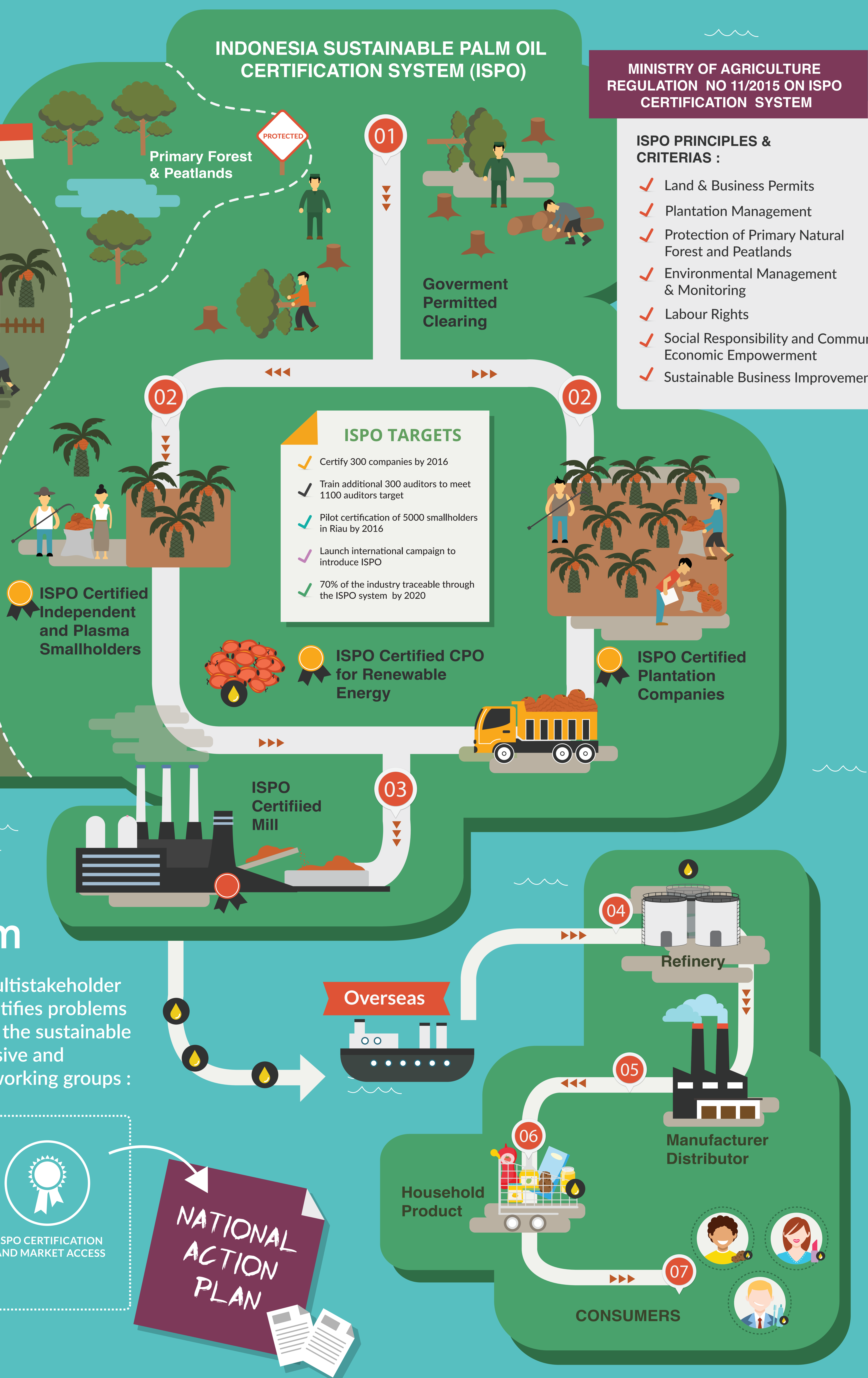
