

# COBERM A Joint EU-UNDP Initiative



#### What is COBERM?

COBERM is a joint EU-UNDP initiative that promotes involvement of local Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) in a wide range of areas and activities, including support to immediate and concrete initiatives, seeking to have a demonstrable impact on building confidence among communities affected by conflict. COBERM has been set up in May 2010. In the following five years (2010-2015), it had successfully implemented 137 sub projects and building on this success, a third phase of COBERM was launched in January 2016.

COBERM is an apolitical, impartial and flexible mechanism.

The main aims of COBERM are the following:

- Support innovative people-to-people confidence-building opportunities;
- 2) Help create an environment conducive to fostering peace, stability and human security.

#### **COBERM III Round II Call for Project Proposals**


Following a first Call for Proposals in February 2016, under which 21 projects were selected for funding, second Call was launched in August 2016. Total of 136 project ideas were received from 128 local and 8 international CSOs. Criteria for evaluation of project ideas included: impact on confidence building, conflict sensitivity, sustainability, feasibility and cost efficiency. As a result of a thorough selection process, 24 organizations were invited to submit full project proposals. The full project proposals were further assessed against the above mentioned criteria and, as a result, 9 projects were selected for funding.

## **Strengthening Civil Society Capacity Component**

A Peacebuilding Programme Development workshop with specific focus on strengthening skills and capacities of CSOs in conflict-sensitive programming, increasing knowledge of confidence building concepts and peace-building strategies, as well as international best practices in this field was held in September 2016 for 24 CSOs. Other capacity building activities included over 50 online PCM consultations for CSOs with an international PCM expert, as well as two trainings on grant management guidelines. All these capacity building activities included a networking component. A total of 50 CSOs benefitted from the aforementioned activities that enhanced their skills as a result.
