From the Resource Team

Dear Members,

In the year 2015, United Nations organised and facilitated the process of evolving consensus among all countries to develop 3 Global Documents - <u>Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction</u>, <u>Sustainable Development Goals 2015-30</u> and <u>UNFCC (CoP-21)</u>. The consensus was arrived due to pivotal role played by World leaders, UN agencies, INGOs, Academic and Research Institutions, and thousands of front line workers. The year 2016, will lay down the path for transforming the global documents into actions.

As the global leaders were dialoguing the contents and targets in the Global documents to ensure their respective countries interests are not jeopardized at the global meets. Whereas, the Nature was not in favour for any consensus and some of natural disaster events such as Cyclone Pam in the Republic of Vanuatu in the South Pacific Ocean, Hurricane Joaquin in South East of USA, Earthquake in Nepal and Afghanistan, Cyclone Komen and HudHud, Heavy Rains in West Bengal, Gujarat, Jammu & Kashmir, Assam, Mumbai and Tamil Nadu, causing severe floods; Heat wave in Andhra Pradesh and Telegana, indicated the Nature's fury against little being done to Protect the World by its inhabitants. These events calls for collective wisdom and action at all levels by all stakeholders.

Kudos to the Government of India for playing a significant role at the Global Meets. Before the UNFCC could start in Paris, India pledged to source 40% of its electricity from renewable and other low-carbon sources by 2030; It will be hosting the first AMCDRR in 2016 as a follow-up to SFDRR. Government of India hosted the first 4 day South Asian Annual Disaster Management Exercise" (SAADMEx) workshop (23 to 26 Nov) and one day <u>SAARC</u> workshop on best practices (27 Nov), indicating its seriousness to address DRR and CCA issues in the Asian region.

During the year 2015, DM Community of Practice produced <u>16 knowledge products</u> and shared relevant news and views through 11 Community Updates. Shared information on trainings, workshops and conferences. All these has been possible due to the continued support from members, who shared information, resources and topics for discussion.

In the year 2016, efforts will be made to identify knowledge gaps that could feed into policy and program areas, build linkages with academic and research institutions to foster knowledge dissemination and learning; promote virtual dialogue through webinar, skype and other modes of virtual technology. To make the DM Community more vibrant and relevant, request members to share their contact details, knowledge areas for discussion, research papers for peer review, case studies and documents.

Thank all the members for their support during the year 2015 and eagerly look forward for active participation in the year 2016.



The Paris Climate Change Conference convened from 29 November to 13 December 2015, in Paris (Cop-21), France, brought together over 36,000 participants, nearly 23,100 government officials, 9,400 representatives from UN bodies and agencies, intergovernmental organizations and civil society organizations, and 3,700 members of the media. Focus in Paris centred on advancing negotiations on the Paris Outcome, including a legally-binding agreement and associated decisions, to fulfil the mandate outlined in Durban, South Africa, at COP 17. Earthquake in Manipur

An earthquake measuring 6.7 magnitude hit North East India, near its borders with Myanmar and Bangladesh, killing at least 7 people and injuring over 100 persons. The quake hit at 04:35 local time (23:05 GMT Sunday) about 29km (18 miles) North West of Imphal, the capital of Manipur state.

South India Floods:

The **2015 South Indian floods** resulted from heavy rainfall during the annual North East monsoon in November–December 2015. They affected the Coromandel Coast region of the South Indian states of Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh, and the Union Territory of Puducherry, with Tamil Nadu and the city of Chennai particularly hard-hit. Nearly 600 people have died and over 1.8 million people have been displaced. Damages and losses have unofficially been estimated to exceed US\$15 billion. The flooding has been attributed to the El Niño phenomenon during the El Niño year of 2015.
