Rights of Migrant Labourers in Kerala and Role of Local Government. Experiences and Advice. Reply by 6th June 2014

Kerala Development Society (KDS) is seeking inputs on study to recommend a model of an institutional mechanism with the involvement of local government and other agencies and departments for handling migrants and their problems/ issues in Kerala.

- a. How can the state government address the needs of the migrant labourers?
- b. What steps need to be taken to avoid exploitation of migrant workers (wages, working hours, facilities etc.)?

Ministry of Panchayati Raj (MoPR) is presently running a project titled "Strengthening Capacities of Panchayati Raj Institutions" (PRIs) in partnership with United Nations Development Program (UNDP). An important focus of the project is developing capacities of Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) for Natural Resource Management (NRM). To develop learning material on NRM, MoPR is seeking feedback on:

- b. What should be the content (sub-topics) and structure of resource material for capacity building and training of PRIs on the subjects of NRM?

International Election Visitors Programme

In collaboration with ECI, UNDP under the International Election Visitors Programme designed to witness the General elections 2014 in India hosted 42 delegates from 20 countries. The objective of the visit was to provide an insight into the management of elections and explore areas of mutual interest for future collaboration. The visits are spread across 4 weeks and each delegation travelled to one state. The delegation from Namibian



recently visited Bangalore on 16-17 April 2014.



The delegations were exposed to witness and learn from the various steps in the management of Indian elections and to adapt, where possible to their context; to learn on voter education and participation particularly on ECI's experience in SVEEP programme (Systematic Voter Education and Electoral Participation); to witness security arrangements and preparation of conducting the world's largest election – (830 million strong electorate and a poll process managed by 11 million polling staff); to understand the use of Electronic Voter Machines (EVMs) for free and fair election and to learn about ECI's policy and

election code of conduct.

EVMS to be used for the first time in elections of rural and urban local bodies in Ujjain

Election of urban bodies and Panchayats will be organised with the help of electronic voting machines (EVMs) for the first time. Photo electoral lists will be prepared for conduction of polls. State Election Commission will soon initiate a programme. These directives were issued by State Election Commissioner R Parshuram during a review meeting along with collectors and CEOs of Zila Panchayat

of the division on Thursday. Parshuram sought information about difficulties they face conducting polls of urban body and Panchayats from collectors of urban bodies during divisional review meeting.

MP launches web portal for panchayats to ensure transparency

Madhya Pradesh has launched a web portal called <u>Panchayat Darpan</u> for village panchayats to ensure greater transparency in their functioning. The aim is to bring transparency in operations of panchayats and maintain continuous audits. According to the GoMP, the portal will enable all accounts to be maintained with full details at the Panchayat level and also available in public domain for anybody to know through the website, the amount disbursed and the works undertaken by the three tiers of panchayats. The National e-Governance Plan (NeGP) is being implemented for several years all over the country. The NeGP has its own strengths as the first well organized plan of the government of India for both Central and state level e-governance projects. 27 Mission Mode Projects (MMPs) of NeGP had seen their partial successes. However, many additions such as Stakeholders Needs Analysis, Project Planning and Management, Process Reforms and Reengineering could be identified, especially in the context of technology developments. India slips in the global rankings for freedom of the press

India has slipped down the global rankings for freedom of the press, thanks to what The Annual Index of Media Freedom called "increased interference in content by media owners in the run-up to the 2014 elections". Global press freedom has fallen to its lowest level in over a decade with India ranked 78th and belonging to countries with "partially free media". India's press freedom score declined by a point to 39 "reflecting an increased interference in content by media owners in the run-up to the 2014 elections". Read more at http://bit.ly/PVVRvK

Capacity Building for Undertaking HD Analysis and Procurement of Services in 2014 (From Swaymprabha Das, UNDP, New Delhi)

As a part of the GOI-UNDP project on Human Development towards Bridging Inequalities (HDBI), capacity development and training on various aspects of human development is an important initiative at the national level. Such consultations on HD measurements and analysis are being conducted periodically under the project with active participation from the State Governments and UT Administrations. Participants to the training programme are, largely, government officials from States and UTs, and the State Governments may suggest participants from local academic institutes, research organisation, etc. The number of participants per programme is limited to 30 and trainings will be conducted at IIT Guwahati, XIMB Bhubaneswar, ATI-Mysore and YASHADA-Pune.
